# SESSIONAL PAPER NO. 12, 1964 (First Session)

## SANITATION IN FOOD PROCESSING AND SERVING ESTABLISHMENTS

Food processing and serving establishments in existence in the Northwest Territories may be divided into the following categories:-

- (a) Eating and Drinking Establishments
- (b) Milk Processing Plants
- (c) Bakeries
- (d) Fish Packing and Exporting Establishments

For some years, the regular inspection of these establishments has been carried out by the Public Health Engineering Division of the Department of National Health and Welfare. These regular inspections were supplemented by those carried out by the local Medical Health Officers. Inspections of these premises have not been as frequent as is considered desirable, due to difficulty in recruiting staff for the vacant posts of sanitarian at Inuvik and at the Zone Office at Edmonton. It is these personnel who would normally be responsible for the supervision of sanitary conditions in food establishments, but in their absence, the Public Health Engineering Division kindly consented to help out in this matter.

A Schedule of Eating and Drinking Establishments in the Northwest Territories is attached herewith together with the rating given to them by the Public Health Engineering Division. A total of 55 establishments is listed, 40 of which may be classed as commercial types, and the remainder are operated by Government Departments for the benefit of employees or pupils.

The sanitary conditions of eating and drinking establishments in the Northwest Territories have improved considerably during the past five years. Of the 55 listed facilities, 42 are noted as generally satisfactory, 9 as only fairly satisfactory and 4 as unsatisfactory. During the past five years, 'closure' was imposed upon 4 places (2 at Hay Hiver, 1 at Inurik and 1 at Fort Smith) but only after due warning was given, and where there was a continuing danger to the health of the public. Those establishments doing the largest volume of food and drink service, i.e. cafeterias and beverage rooms have adequate equipment and sanitary services. It is the smaller establishments which most frequently contravene the Health Regulations, as (a) funds for improvement are limited, and (b) the operators often have little or no knowledge of food hygiene.

One of the major difficulties in the control of food and drink establishments in the Northwest Territories is the deficiencies in the existing legislation. The present position is that any person can, upon payment of a prescribed fee, demand a business licence to operate an establishment which is governed by Health Regulations, even though that same establishment contravenes all the stipulations of the Regulations. The Health Authority may, as soon as the establishment opens, inspect, and if necessary, issue a 'closure order', but this is a most unsatisfactory arrangement. Representations have been made to the Commissioner to create Regulations under the Business Licence Ordinance whereby a person wishing to open a business which is subject to Health Regulations must have the written approval of a Health Officer before a business licence can be issued. Such legislation, when passed, will give the Health Authority much more necessary control over the establishment of food processing and serving businesses. It should be mentioned that the only realistic way to control sanitary requirements in public buildings is to have legislation which demands submission of scale drawings of the buildings to the Health Authority, the Fire Marshall, and the Engineering Authority, who should all approve before a building permit is issued. There have been occasions when large hotels and restaurants have been built in which both Health and Fire Regulations were not observed with the result that the proprietor, having incurred heavy expenditure erecting a building, found that he was not allowed to operate it unless he carried out major alterations.

Some people may state that such regulations should not be enforced in a developing community, and they may talk of hindering private enterprise. This is not a logical argument, as the health requirements would be no different than they are now, and yet the owner would be protected from erecting a building which would contravene Territorial regulations. Such a requirement is normal practice in Southern communities, and it is recommended that such a practice be considered for Municipalities, Local Improvement Districts, and Development Areas in the Northwest Territories.

#### Milk Processing Plants -

At the present time there are only two such plants in operation in the Territories, and neither can be considered satisfactory. Milk is an excellent food, but unfortunately it is also an ideal culture medium for bacteria, and it is imperative, in the interest of public health, that strict sanitary requirements are enforced. With this in mind, a draft set of 'Milk Regulations' has been submitted to the Commissioner which, if approved, will effectively control the production and distribution of this product in the Northwest Territories.

#### Inspections -

As previously mentioned, inspections have been carried out by the Public Health Engineering Division of the Department of National Health and Velfare. However, this Division is now being re-organized and is giving up most of its inspectoral duties, and has requested that it be relieved of routine inspections of food and drink establishments in the Territories. This means that it is now a matter of urgency to recruit Sanitarians for this type of work. The main reason of our failure to recruit in the past has been the very low salaries offered -- these have now been increased slightly from  $\frac{1}{2}$  to  $\frac{1}{2}$  do  $\frac{1}{2}$  do  $\frac{1}{2}$  and while some difficulty in recruitment is still envisaged it is hoped that the increase in salary may entice suitable candidates to apply for the vacant posts.

If and when suitable personnel are recruited for the two vacant posts of Sanitarian at Inuvik and Edmonton and for the third position which has been requested for Churchill, frequent regular inspections of all food processing and serving establishments should be possible, and consideration could also be given to holding special courses for food-handlers and hotel-operators in the major centres in the Territories.
