GENERAL

Payroll statistics for 1964 again reflect an increase in commercial activity in the Northwest Territories.

ADMINISTRATION

Five Hundred and Seventeen (517) employers operated in the Northwest Territories in 1964-65 compared to Four Hundred and Seventy-Seven (477) for 1963-64.

A Summary showing how these employers were classed for insurance purposes is included in Appendix "H".

AMENDMENTS

No amendments were made to the Northwest Territories Workmen's Compensation Ordinance in 1964-65.

ENFORCEMENT

The Administrator of the Mackenzie and his staff have been very helpful to this office in dealing with enforcement problems relating to proper compensation insurance coverage and submission of Employer's Payroll Statements.

The Royal Canadian Mounted Police have also co-operated in enforcement matters. On June 23, 1964, the Workman's Compensation Officer filed an Information and Complaint with the Hay River R.C.M. Police Detachment. A local employer was charged under Section 42 (1) (b) Northwest Territories Workmen's Compensation Ordinance for failing to submit payroll statements. He was fined \$50.00 plus costs of \$4.50. This Court Action seemed to have a good effect on other delinquent employers.

ASSESSMENT

The Administrative Assessment fee, payable by each insured employer on the assessable payroll, remained at 1/10th of 1%.

The net assessment fees together with exemption fees collected from employers amounted to \$26,330.90 for 1964-65.

EXPENDITURES

The overall cost of operating the Edmonton Compensation Office increased from \$36,922.09 in 1963-64 to \$39,011.07. The Northwest Territories share of these costs was \$18,409.54. The increase in cost resulted from the general increase in salaries retroactive to October, 1963, and to the fact that the Establishment was brought up to strength in September, 1964.

In order to handle the increasing work load, four members of the staff put in 667 hours of official overtime during the past year. Besides this they worked several hundred hours of overtime which was not claimed.

CLAIMS

One Thousand and Seventy-Nine (1,079) accident claims were processed by this office in 1964, an increase of One Hundred and Sixty-Seven (167) from the previous year.

Seven Hundred and Twenty-Four (724) were non-compensable;

Three Hundred and Forty-Two (342) were temporary disabilities;

There were three (3) fatal accidents and ten (10) permanent disabilities;

Fifty (50) claims were referred to the Referee.

CLAIMS (Continued)

Total compensation paid to workmen injured in 1964 amounted to \$101,733.54. Medical payments reported, totalled \$74,290.85 for 1964 accidents.

Compensation and medical payments listed above include only payments made to date for eighty-four (84) uncompleted claims. Payments made each year following the date of the accident are shown in Appendix "E".

INSPECTION TRIP

The Workmen's Compensation Officer visited Fort Smith, Hay River, and Yellowknife last year, to deal with some of the more difficult problems relating to claims and enforcement.
