CONCERNING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR A LIBRARY

The Pine Point Community Association is interested in establishing a small lending library in the community.

We are aware that in 1967 Hay River will have a large library that will service the whole Territories. This will indeed be a great boon.

In the meantime, it is our plan to purchase as many books as our budget will allow and to establish a loaning service with a larger library. We have made inquiries to the Extension Library, University of Alberta, Edmonton, and to the Hay River Library.

It would be our plan to put the books we purchase into circulation with the travelling centennial library once it is established.

It is our understanding that in the past the government has given financial assistance to libraries for the purchasing of books. We would be most pleased to have your assurance that we could gain your assistance in order to undertake this venture.
