Oral Question 744-18(2) Northern Frontier Visitors' Centre

This letter is in follow-up to the Oral Question you raised on May 25, 2017 about whether the Department of Infrastructure (INF) would place signage along the highway system to direct tourists to the new temporary location of the Northern Frontier Visitors' Centre.

INF coordinated with the Department of Industry, Tourism and Investment (ITI) and the City of Yellowknife to relocate the visitor information directional sign from its previous location in front of Yellowknife Motors to kilometre 0.3 on the Yellowknife Access Road, near the intersection to the Legislative Assembly. The Highway Maintenance crew moved the sign June 15, 2017. The new placement of this internationally recognized tourist information sign will help direct visitors to the current Northern Frontier Visitors' Centre location at the Prince of Wales Northern Heritage Centre. Additional signage may be considered once the permanent location of the Visitors' Centre has been chosen.
