Oral Question 692-18(2): Public Safety on the Ingraham Trail

Ensuring driver safety on territorial highways remains a top priority for the Department of Transportation (DOT). DOT is committed to reviewing its existing communication strategy to identify opportunities to improve upon methods used to inform the public of incidents that occur on the Ingraham Trail. The Department will seek input from stakeholders such as Ingraham Trail and Dettah residents, the RCMP, the Department of Municipal and Community Affairs, the City of Yellowknife, and Aboriginal groups in the area.
