Oral Question 250-18(2): GNWT Campaign to Eliminate Family Violence

This letter is in follow up to the Oral Question you raised on June 17, 2016 regarding the GNWT campaign to eliminate family violence.

We have recently been provided updated 'What will it Take?' workshop and participant numbers by FOXY. In 2015/16 FOXY delivered twenty-eight workshops in seventeen communities reaching a total of 340 youth:

- Fort Smith: 3 workshops between October 27 and 29, 2015
- Norman Wells: 1 workshop on November 3, 2015
- Fort Providence: 2 workshops on November 19-20, 2015

- o Tuktoyaktuk: 1 workshop on February 4, 2016
- Hay River: 3 workshops on February 8 -10, 2016
- Hay River Reserve: 1 workshop on February 11, 2016
- Fort Resolution: 1 workshop on February 12, 2016
- Whatì: 2 workshops on February 16 & 17, 2016
- o N'dilo: 1 workshop on March 2, 2016
- Aklavik: 1 workshop on March 8, 2016
- Fort McPherson: 2 workshops on March 9-10, 2016
- Łutselk'e: 2 workshops on March 15-16, 2016
- Fort Liard: 1 workshop on March 22, 2016
- Fort Simpson: 2 workshops on March 23-24, 2016
- Ulukhaktok: 2 workshops on March 30-31, 2016
