# Applying for the Extended Health Benefits for Specified Disease Conditions Program

## Who can apply for Extended Health Benefits (EHB)?

- A permanent resident of the Northwest Territories (NWT)
- Métis or non-Indigenous
- · Have a valid NWT Health Care Card
- For the Specified Disease Conditions Program, you must be under the care of a physician or nurse practitioner for one of these disease conditions:

Please Note: If you have access to benefits under an employer or similar plan, and choose not to use them, you will not be eligible for assistance under the EHB Specified Disease Conditions Program.

A health care card is required to receive health care benefits.
