An application for an investigation under the *Environmental Rights Act* was submitted in 2013-2014.

In 2013, the Council of Canadians submitted an application to the Minister of Environment and Natural Resources outlining concerns regarding oil and gas development in the Mackenzie Valley and the use of drilling fluids. Since the company in question had obtained the appropriate land use permit and water licence through the appropriate processes, the Minister declined the investigation and no further action was taken.
