## Oral Question 131-18(3) Amendments to the <u>Cities, Towns and Villages Act</u> for a Hotel Tax Levy

This letter is in follow up to the Oral Questions you raised on February 20, 2018 related to amendments to the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act (CTVA*). You asked questions about the timeline for the project, the consultation that had taken place, when a legislative proposal would be submitted and when a draft Bill could be anticipated.

The Department of Municipal and Community Affairs (MACA) received confirmation that the legislative proposal to amend the CTVA was approved by Cabinet on April 26, 2018. Proposed amendments to the CTVA would allow municipal corporations established under the Act to:

- 1. Levy a tax on tourist accommodations within the boundaries of the municipal corporation; and
- 2. Pass a bylaw allowing property owners to finance energy retrofits or the implementation of renewable energy technologies through a local improvement charge on their property.

Efforts to complete the drafting of the Bill are now nearing completion, and MACA anticipates introduction of *An Act to Amend the Cities, Towns and Villages Act* in the May/June sitting of the Legislative Assembly.

This project has involved consultation with the six communities established under the CTVA and in particular ongoing consultation with the City of Yellowknife. MACA also reached out to tourist accommodation operators in each of the six CTV communities and financial lenders within the territory. Efforts were also made to communicate with Northwest Territories Association of Communities (NWTAC) and the Northwest Territories Tourism Association (NWTTA).

In addition to stakeholder consultation and given the fact that the proposed Bill deals with the delegation of taxation authority by the Legislative Assembly, engagement with the Department Finance and the Department of Justice has been necessary to ensure that this delegation is clear and unambiguous and that the Government of the Northwest Territories has been diligent in ensuring a smooth, effective and responsible delegation of this authority.
