## Oral Question 119-18(3): Medical Travel Coverage

This letter is in reference to the Oral Question raised on February 15, 2018 regarding Medical Travel for Traditional Healing Treatments.

As stated in the House, Government of the Northwest Territories Medical Travel does not cover the travel cost to attend traditional healer services. However, the Federal Non-Insured Health Benefit (NIHB) program offers Medical transportation benefits to see a traditional healer. However NIHB must consider certain criteria prior to approving medical transportation benefits for traditional healer services.
