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GENERAL

Payroll statistics for 1965 reflect increased commercial activity in the Northwest Territories.

ADMINISTRATION

Five Hundred and Fifty-seven (557) employers operated in the Northwest Territories in 1965-66 compared to Five Hundred and Seventeen (517) in 1964-65.

A Summary showing how these employers were classed for insurance purposes is included in Appendix "H".

AMENDMENTS

No amendments were made to the Northwest Territories Workmen's Compensation Ordinance in 1965-66.

In December 1965, a three-man Workmen's Compensation Inquiry Board was formed as agreed to at the June, 1965 Council Session, to review Workmen's Compensation Legislation for the Northwest Territories and Yukon that has been in force since early 1953. The Board members were:

The Board of Enquiry officially convened meetings at Fort Smith, Inuvik, Yellowknife, Hay River, Watson Lake, Whitehorse, Edmonton and Ottawa.

ENFORCEMENT

Although the Administrator of the Mackenzie and his staff have continued to help this office, problems relating to enforcement are increasing in degree and in number. In some cases, Employers, Doctors and Workmen are very slow in submitting reports and statements and some Employers are delinquent in obtaining proper Compensation coverage. Provincial Compensation Boards can impose monetary penalties for late reporting and for other infractions without recourse to the Courts; this Administration can not take this kind of enforcement action. While we can and do occasionally take Court action against an Employer for a serious or flagrant violation of the Compensation Ordinance, this action does not solve our enforcement problems. To help overcome the enforcement problems and the attendant delay in handling Compensation claims, the Workmen's Compensation Officer should spend more time in the field doing Educational and Liaison work with Employers, Workmen and Doctors.

ASSESSMENT

The Administrative Assessment fee, payable by each insured employer on the assessable payroll, remained at 1/10th of 1%.

The net assessment fees together with exemption fees collected from employers amounted to \$20,974.74 for 1965-66, compared to \$26,330.90 for 1964-65.

The revenue figures for net assessments and exemption fees do not, in any given fiscal year, accurately reflect Commercial activity trends. Frequently employers either over or under-estimate

their payrolls at the beginning of the policy period, consequently assessment adjustments must be made at the end of the period. In many instances the adjustments are not made within the fiscal year to which the assessments were credited.

EXPENDITURES

To overall cost of operating the Edmonton Compensation Office increased from \$39,011.07 in 1964-65 to \$45,736.11. The Northwest Territories share of these costs was \$22,263.03. The increase in cost resulted from the general increase in salaries retroactive to October, 1965, and to the increase in the Referee's fee from \$4,800.00 in 1964 to \$7,000.00 in 1965.

CLAIMS

One Thousand One Hundred and Six (1,106) accident claims were handled by this office in 1965, an increase of Twenty-seven from the previous year.

CLAIMS (Continued)

Seven Hundred and Eighty-Eight (788) were non-compensable;

Three Hundred and Nine (309) were temporary disabilities;

There were three (3) fatal accidents and six (6) permanent disabilities;

Sixty-Nine (69) claims were referred to the Referee.

Total compensation paid to workmen injured in 1965 amounted to \$100,940.23. Medical payments reported, totalled \$100,199.02 for 1965 accidents.

Compensation and medical payments listed above include payments made in 1965 on one hundred and twenty-one (121) uncompleted claims. Payments made in 1965 for accidents prior to 1965 are shown in Appendices "D" and "E".

INSPECTION AND TRAVEL, WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION OFFICER

To deal with matters related to difficult claims and enforcement the Workmen's Compensation Officer visited Fort Smith, Yellowknife, Hay River, Pine Point, Inuvik, Aklavik and Discovery Mine.

He attended the Annual Convention of the Association of Workmen's Compensation Boards held in Winnipeg August 22-26, 1965.

He travelled to Fort Smith and Yellowknife with the "Workmen's Compensation Inquiry Board" and attended hearings at these points as well as hearings in Edmonton and Ottawa.
