**NORTHWEST TERRITORIES APPRENTICE TRAINING
AND OCCUPATIONAL CERTIFICATION PROGRAM
APRIL 1, 1965 - MARCH 31, 1966 ANNUAL REPORT**

Twenty-one occupations have now been analysed and produced in record book form and a further four are in preparation. Examinations have also been established in these occupations.

Fifty-four apprentices are registered and an increase is expected. The following occupational certificates have been issued:

The 41 Department of Northern Affairs and National Resources trades apprentice positions have almost all been filled and an additional four in laundry and dry cleaning are expected to be filled during 1966-67.
