## NORTHWEST TERRITORIES APPRENTICE TRAINING FOR AND LOCCUPATIONAL COERTIFICATION OF TRAINING APRIL 1, 1965 - MARCHOS1, 1966 ANNUAL REPORT

Twenty-one occupations have now been analysed and produced in record book form and a further four are in preparation. Examinations have also been established in these occupations.

Fifty-four apprentices are registered and an increase is expected. The following occupational certificates have been issued:
