Transfer from Operations Expenditure funding for the debt service payments associated with the Deh Cho Bridge, which are capitalized during the construction phase of the project.

SPECIAL WARRANT – A special warrant was approved on December 14, 2012 to fund 1,028,000 the construction of the Nahanni Butte access road damaged during a flood in June 2012.

The costs will partially be recovered through the Government of Canada's Disaster

Financial Assistance Arrangements, administered by Public Safety Canada.

To provide funding to allow for the upgrade of Source 177 access road, additional geotechnical investigations, continue environmental/engineering work and project management related to the Inuvik to Tuktoyaktuk Highway (ITH) Project.

These costs will be partially recovered from the federal government for this cost-shared project.
