Midwifery Services

The Minister of Health and Social Services response is that:

- The Department is committed to developing a sustainable plan that will improve the health of mothers and babies throughout pregnancy, delivery and the first months of life;
- Developing a territorial midwifery program is a key priority action in the Department's Strategic Plan. Allowing patients to access safe, quality services as close to home as possible remains a priority of the Department;
- The Department is working on identifying additional funds to continue a phased expansion of midwifery;
- During the 2013-2014 fiscal year, the Department will be undertaking community engagement activities in Hay River and other communities to discuss the proposed integration of midwifery care into the current delivery model; and,
- The Department will be working with the Advisory Committee for Midwifery to revise the Midwifery Practice Framework to ensure it reflects current scope of practice and standards.
