

Respite Services in the Northwest Territories

As announced in the House on November 03, 2010, the government is committed to having one territorial respite care program for families in need of a respite care program, which would include Yellowknife families. The Department of Health and Social Services (Department) has been instructed to develop a proposal and implementation plan for a territorial program that will ensure families continue to receive respite services while developing a territorial respite program.

The Department's work on a territorial respite program will be prepared for the next budget cycle. The government will also seek support from all Members for inclusion in the future business plans. The Minister of Health and Social Services will come before Standing Committee on Social Programs to discuss the continued support for respite services in the Northwest Territories.
