"... own or lease a principal residence in a Northwest Territories community outside the capital may claim reimbursement, to set maximums, for relocation and removal costs, lease costs for temporary accommodation in the capital, one-time real estate fees, as well as the costs of utilities and furniture."

Report on Ministerial Benefits Policies For the Fiscal Year Ending 31 March 2010

The Ministerial Benefits Policy, Medical Travel, Sick Leave, Vacation Leave, Health, Dental and Life Insurance Benefits (4.0) provides that Members of the Executive Council are:

"... eligible to receive medical travel, sick leave, vacation leave, health, dental and life insurance benefits, at the same rates, and under the same conditions, provided to senior management group in the Government of the Northwest Territories public service."

The following benefits were paid under this policy in the fiscal year ending 31 March 2010:

- (a) Medical Travel no assistance was provided under this policy in the fiscal year ending 31 March 2010.
- (b) Sick Leave all Members of the Executive Council earned sick leave days at a rate of 9.375 hours of per month in the fiscal year ending 31 March 2010.
