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### **Instructions to Bidders**

1. Late tenders will not be accepted.
2. All tenders must be on the Tender Form provided, and failure to do so will result in the bid being rejected as non-responsive. It must be signed by a duly authorized representative of the bidder. Incomplete or illegible tenders will be rejected.
3. Tenders and amendments will be accepted in sealed envelopes or packages in accordance with the following conditions:
  - a) they should be properly identified on the outside of the envelope or package stating the Bidder's Name, Tender Reference Number, Tender Title and Closing Date and Time. Any bidder submitting a tender or amendment lacking this information on the outside of the envelope or package does so at their bidder's risk.
  - b) they are delivered to the address provided above on or before the Closing Date and Time.
4. Tenders or amendments sent by means of e-mail will not be accepted.
5. Tenders and any amendments sent by facsimile will be accepted in accordance with the following conditions:
  - a) tenders and any amendments must be received in full on or before the Closing Date and Time at the facsimile number identified above and include the Bidder's Name, Tender Reference Number, Tender Title and Closing Date and Time.
  - b) the BDHSSA cannot guarantee the confidentiality of information contained in the tender or amendments.
  - c) the BDHSSA will not be liable for any claim, demand or actions for any damages whatsoever should a facsimile transmission be interrupted, not received in its entirety, received after the stated Closing Date and Time, received by any other facsimile unit other than that stated herein, or for any other reason.
6. All tenders are irrevocable for a period of thirty (30) days from the Closing Date and Time.
7. If a tender or amendment contains a defect, or fails to comply with the requirements of this tender, the BDHSSA at its sole discretion reserves the right to accept the tender if it determines that the defect or failure to comply is immaterial.
8. In the event all tenders, or amendments, have material defects, or fail to comply with the requirements of this tender, the BDHSSA reserves the right to either cancel the tender call or to accept the tender deemed to be in the best interest of the BDHSSA.
9. The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted. The BDHSSA reserves the right to cancel the tender, in whole or in part, at any time for any reason whatsoever, and may at the sole option of the BDHSSA, re-issue the same thereafter, without incurring any liability to any bidder and no bidder shall have any claim against the BDHSSA.
10. The BDHSSA reserves the right to negotiate price, scope of work, or both, with the responsible and responsive bidder determined to have submitted the lowest bid after applying the Business Incentive Policy adjustment(s).
11. One of the priorities of the BDHSSA is to ensure local and northern materials, equipment and labour are used to the fullest extent practical on any BDHSSA contract. Therefore, the Business Incentive Policy, 63.02 applies to this tender. Bidders can obtain information on the G.N.W.T. Business Incentive Policy from the web site: <http://www.itl.gov.nt.ca/ica/bip/index.htm>, or the BIP Monitoring Office at 867-873-7215 or 867-920-3182.
12. Addenda issued prior to the tender Closing Date and Time will be in writing and must be incorporated into the tender.
13. Verbal responses to any inquiry cannot be relied upon and are not to be construed as an implied term of this tender or any resultant contract.
14. All unit prices must be extended and totalled, and failure to do so will result in the bid being rejected as non-responsive. The extended price is derived by multiplying the unit price by the quantity of units required. In the event of an error in calculation of the extended price, the unit price will be taken as correct and will govern in the bid evaluation and resulting contract.
15. All prices must be quoted in Canadian dollars and are to be exclusive of the Goods and Services Tax ("the GST").
16. All documents, including tenders and amendments, submitted to the BDHSSA are in the custody and under the control of the BDHSSA. Bidders, in submitting tenders or amendments, acknowledge that the BDHSSA may be required to release, in whole or in part, the documents in accordance with the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act.
17. Unless otherwise stated, equivalents to the goods detailed in this document are encouraged. Where goods are required to conform to "Standards specifications" (eg. CSA, CGSB, ASTM), or are described by a trade name, model, or manufacturer this is for the purpose of establishing and defining the nature and minimum quality acceptable but does not prevent bidders from offering alternative goods nor does it preclude the BDHSSA from considering, or accepting, same. However, bidders should provide, with the tender, documents that clearly show that the alternative(s) offered equal or exceed the standards specified. The BDHSSA, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to accept or reject the alternative offered as responsive or not responsive as the case may be.
18. All prices must include charges for containers, packing, cartage to the F.O.B. point and no additional charges will be accepted by the BDHSSA.



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### General Conditions

1. **DEFINITIONS.** In the contract:
  - i. Contracting Authority means (i) a Minister or (ii) a Deputy Minister and includes a public officer who has been delegated the powers and duties of a contract officer.
  - ii. G N W T means the Government of the Northwest Territories
  - iii. Contractor means the legal entity that has been awarded the contract.
  - iv. Work means the goods, services or construction as set out herein
2. **APPLICABLE LAW:** This contract shall be interpreted and governed in accordance with the laws of the Northwest Territories and the laws of Canada as they apply in the Northwest Territories.
3. **ENTIRE CONTRACT:** This contract, including the Signature Page, General Conditions, Supplementary Conditions and any attached Schedules, comprises the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all written or oral communications, negotiations and agreements relating to the Work made prior to the date of this contract.
4. **STATUTORY CONDITION:** It is a condition of this contract that payment hereunder is subject to Section 46 of the Financial Administration Act, as amended, which provides as follows: "It is a condition of every contract made by or on behalf of the government requiring an expenditure, that an expenditure pursuant to the contract will be incurred only if there is a sufficient unencumbered balance in the appropriated item for the fiscal year in which the expenditure is required under the contract."
5. **INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR:** The Contractor is an independent Contractor with the BDHSSA and nothing in this contract shall be construed or deemed to create the relationship of employee and employer or of principle and agent between the BDHSSA and the Contractor. The Contractor is solely responsible for payments of all statutory deductions or contributions including but not limited to pension plans, employment insurance, income tax, workers' compensation and the G N W T Payroll Tax.
6. **TIME:** Time is of the essence of this contract, both with respect to times, dates, or periods specified in the contract; and any times, dates, or periods that may be substituted for any of those in the contract, by agreement between the BDHSSA and the Contractor.
7. **IMPLIED TERMS:** No implied terms or obligations of any kind by or on behalf of either party to this contract shall arise from anything in the contract and the express covenants and agreements therein contained and made by the parties to this contract are the only covenants and agreements upon which any rights against the parties are to be founded.
8. **AMENDMENTS:** This contract may only be amended, extended or renewed by the written consent of the parties.
9. **SUCCESSION:** This contract shall accrue to the benefit of and be binding upon the administrators, executors, successors, and assigns of Contractor and the successors and assigns of the BDHSSA.
10. **SEVERANCE OF TERMS:** It is intended that all provisions of this contract shall be fully binding and effective between the parties, but in the event that any particular provision or provisions or a part of one is found to be void, voidable or unenforceable for any reason whatever, then the particular provision shall be deemed severed from the remainder of this Contract and all other provisions shall remain in full force.
11. **ASSIGNMENT AND SUBCONTRACTING:** The Contractor shall not assign, transfer or sub-contract any of the Work to be done under this contract, or any part thereof, to any party without prior written consent of the BDHSSA. If, with the consent of the BDHSSA the Work or any part thereof is performed by a subcontractor, the Contractor shall be fully responsible to the BDHSSA for the acts and omissions of the sub-contractor and all its officers, servants and agents. In the case of a proposed assignment of monies owing to the Contractor under this contract, the Contractor acknowledges that the consent in writing of the Comptroller General of the G.N.W.T. must be obtained in accordance with s.69(4) of the Financial Administration Act.
12. **WAIVER OF BREACH:** No waiver by either party of any breach of any term, condition, or covenant of this contract shall be effective unless the waiver is in writing and signed by both parties. A waiver, with respect to any breach shall not affect the rights of the parties relating to other or future breaches.
13. **PERFORMANCE:** The failure of either party at any time to require the performance of any provision or requirement of this Contract shall not affect the right of that party to require the subsequent performance of that provision or requirement.
14. **NOTICE:** Any notice required to be given herein or any other communication to either party pursuant to this contract shall be in writing and shall be personally delivered, sent by facsimile, email, or posted by prepaid registered mail at the address on the front of this contract.
15. **GOODS & SERVICES TAX:** The BDHSSA certifies that the Work to be purchased from the Contractor will be purchased with government funds and are not, therefore, subject to the Goods and Services Tax (GST) or the Harmonized Sales Tax (HST). Even though the Contractor will not charge GST or HST, the Contractor may be eligible to receive input tax credits with respect to any GST or HST liability incurred in providing the Work if such a refund would be available in other circumstances. It is the sole responsibility of the Contractor to determine if input tax credits are available in respect of the provision of the Work to the BDHSSA. The BDHSSA will not compensate the Contractor for any GST or HST liability incurred in the provision of the Work.
16. **WORKPLACE CONFLICT:** The parties and their employees, agents, and representatives shall observe and be bound by the Workplace Conflict Resolution Policy of the G.N.W.T. as it applies to this contract. A copy of the Workplace Conflict Resolution Policy can be found at the following website <http://www.hrt.gov.nt.ca/policy/documents/Workplaceconflictresolutionpolicy.pdf>. The Contractor shall, upon the request of the BDHSSA, remove from any BDHSSA work site where the contract work is being performed, any person employed by it for the purposes of the contract who, in the opinion of the BDHSSA, has violated the Workplace Conflict Resolution Policy.
17. **ACCESS TO INFORMATION:** All information, including documents, submitted to the BDHSSA are in the custody and control of the BDHSSA and thus subject to the protection and disclosure provisions of the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act. This Act allows any person a right of access to the records in the custody or under the control of a public body subject to limited and specific exemptions.
18. **CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES:**
19. **EQUIPMENT:** The Contractor shall furnish all tools, equipment, labour, supervision, materials and other supplies and services necessary for the execution and completion of the Work, at the Contractor's sole expense, unless otherwise specified in writing to the contrary.
20. **SUBCONTRACTORS:** The Contractor shall ensure that any subcontractors engaged to perform any portion of the Work will be bound by the terms and conditions essentially the same as those in this contract, to the extent that they are applicable to the goods or services provided by the subcontractor.
21. **COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS:** The Contractor shall comply with all legal requirements, and shall have and maintain, at its cost, all permits, licences and fees required for the performance of the Work.



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### General Conditions

21. **INDEMNITY:** The Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the BDHSSA, its officers, employees, servants and agents from and against all claims, actions, causes of action, demands, costs, losses, damages, expenses, suits or other proceedings by whomever made, brought or prosecuted in any manner based upon or related to the activities of the Contractor under this contract.
22. **RECORDS:** The Contractor shall keep proper accounts and records of this contract for a period of 1 year after the expiry of this agreement. At any time during the term of this contract or the three years after the expiry of this contract, the Contractor, upon request of the BDHSSA shall produce such accounts and records.
23. **CONFIDENTIALITY:** The Contractor shall ensure that all and any information related to the affairs of the BDHSSA to which the Contractor becomes privy as a result of this contract, is confidential and shall be treated as confidential during and after the term of this contract and shall not be divulged, released or published without the prior written approval of the BDHSSA.
24. **NOTICE OF CLAIM:** The Contractor shall give notice to the BDHSSA immediately of any claim, action, or other proceeding made, brought, prosecuted, or threatened in writing to be brought or prosecuted that is based upon, occasioned by or in any way attributable to the performance or non-performance of the service under this contract.
25. **INVOICING:** The Contractor must submit to the BDHSSA an invoice in satisfactory form upon completion of the Work or at other times as required.

### BDHSSA RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

26. **BREACH OF CONTRACT:** The BDHSSA, having given written notice of a breach, may withhold or hold back in whole or in part any payment due the Contractor without penalty, expense or liability, if in the opinion of the Contracting Authority, the Contractor has failed to comply with or has in any way breached an obligation of the Contractor. Any such holdbacks shall continue until the breach has been rectified to the satisfaction of the BDHSSA.
27. **DEFAULT:** In the event that the Contractor is, in the opinion of the Contracting Authority, in default in respect of any of the obligations under this Contract hereunder the BDHSSA may do any act it deems necessary to rectify such default and may deduct or set off the cost of such rectification against any amount or payment due to the Contractor.
28. **SET OFF:** The BDHSSA may set off any payment due to the Contractor pursuant to this contract against any monies owed by the Contractor to the BDHSSA.
29. **TERMINATION:** The BDHSSA may terminate this contract at any time, upon giving written notice to this effect to the Contractor if, in the opinion of the Contracting Authority: the Contractor is unable to perform the Work as required; the Contractor's performance of the Work is faulty; the Contractor becomes insolvent or commits an act of bankruptcy; in the event any actual or potential labour dispute delays or threatens to delay timely performance of this contract; or the Contractor defaults or fails to observe the terms and conditions of this contract in any material respect. This contract shall terminate as of the day for termination set out in the written notice.
30. **PAYMENT:** Upon completion of the Work, or any agreed upon part thereof, and provided all terms and conditions hereof on the part of the Contractor have been complied with, the BDHSSA shall pay each invoice from the Contractor within thirty (30) calendar days after its receipt, or thirty (30) calendar days after delivery of the Work, whichever is later. Invoices from Northern Contractors (as defined by the G.N.W.T. Business Incentive Policy, 63.02) will be paid twenty (20) calendar days after receipt of the invoice, or twenty (20) calendar days after delivery of the Work, whichever is later.
31. **LIABILITY:** The BDHSSA, its servants and agents, shall not be liable to the Contractor, its officers, servants, agents or subcontractors for any loss, damage or injury (including death) or for any loss or damage to the property of the Contractor, or property of others for which the Contractor is responsible, how ever arising or in any manner based upon, arising from or attributable to the performance of this contract; and the Contractor waives all rights and recourse against the BDHSSA for any such loss, damage, or injury or loss or damage to the Contractor's property or property of others for which the Contractor is responsible.



## REQUEST FOR TENDERS GOODS

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### Conditions - Goods Supply

1. The Contractor shall provide the goods set out herein to the full satisfaction of the BDHSSA.
2. Goods supplied will be subject to inspection and may be rejected if they do not meet specifications or are in any way unfit for the purpose or use intended, and shall be returned to the Contractor at no cost to the BDHSSA.
3. The BDHSSA shall not accept any condition or reservation, customary or otherwise, subject to which the Contractor may purport to sell, ship or deliver the goods other than those stated herein.
4. The reference numbers on contracts must be clearly shown on all invoices, packing slips, express receipts, Bills of Lading, and on all packing cases and each separate piece of material, as well as all relevant correspondence. Invoices shall include contract reference numbers and list all goods supplied, and where available, corresponding serial numbers are to be included with all goods listed.
5. Failure to comply with any condition may result in cancellation of the contract with no liability on the part of the BDHSSA for any losses, damages, expenses or costs incurred by the Contractor.
6. Delivery of the goods required must be made within the time and manner stipulated in the contract documents.
7. The Contractor shall ensure the BDHSSA receives the manufacturer's warranty for the goods purchased notwithstanding any manufacturer's warranties the Contractor agrees to warrant and assume responsibility for all goods (including hardware, firmware, and/or software products) that it leases, contracts or sells to the BDHSSA.
8. The Contractor warrants that all goods delivered are new, free from defects and conform to specifications, drawings and samples specified by the BDHSSA; that his warranty shall survive any inspection, delivery, acceptance, or payment made by the BDHSSA of or for the materials and the purchaser may reject and return, at the risk and expense of the Contractor, any goods which are defective, or do not comply with the said specifications, drawings or samples.
9. The Contractor shall maintain the following insurance coverage for the duration of this contract:
  - Comprehensive General Liability Insurance with a limit of not less than \$2,000,000 inclusive per occurrence for bodily injury, death and damage to property including loss of use thereof
  - Automobile Liability Insurance in respect of the Contractor's owned and leased vehicles with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 inclusive per occurrence for bodily injury, death , and damage to property
