## **Changes to Seniors' Health Benefits Programs**

The proposed changes to the Supplementary Health Benefits Program and Catastrophic Drug Coverage Program were intended to assist residents, and their families, who have comparatively low income and who do not have access to any supplementary health care benefits. The policies to guide these programs were to come into effect on April 1, 2009.

On February 10, 2009, in response to concerns raised by the public and the Members of the Legislative Assembly about the proposed program, the Minister advised Committee of the Whole that implementation of the Supplementary Health Benefits Policy would be postponed until April 1, 2010 in order to facilitate a review of the program design necessary to advance the Policy's intent and to undertake full consultation with the Members of the House and stakeholders on the Policy's objectives and implementation.
