WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ORDINANCE

The undersigned pursuant to the Workmen's Compensation Ordinance orders as follows:

1. Every person who is a
 - (a) duly ordained and appointed clergyman;
 - (b) member of a religious order; or
 - (c) lay reader

is exempted from the application of the Workmen's Compensation Ordinance while exercising his religious functions as such.

2. Commissioner's Order 162-67 dated July 10, 1967 is revoked.

- (i) "seasonal employee" means a person employed in work of a seasonal nature, which is not continuous throughout the year but recurs in successive years;
 - (j) "standard hours" means the standard hours of work that shall be performed by an employee pursuant to section 8;
 - (k) "transfer" means the appointment of an employee to a new position, that does not constitute a promotion or demotion;
- (2) Where an employee, other than a casual employee, ceases to be employed for any reason other than dismissal, abandonment of position or rejection on probation, and is re-employed within a period of three months, his periods of employment for purposes of public service superannuation shall be considered as continuous employment in the public service.
- (3) Where a person, other than a casual employee, is appointed to a position in the public service within 3 months after terminating his employment in the Public Service of Canada or the Public Service of the Yukon Territory for reasons other than dismissal, abandonment of position or rejection on probation, his periods of employment shall be considered as continuous employment in the public service and all leave credits and benefits earned but not granted shall be considered as earned in the public service.

Selection

3. The selection of persons for appointment to positions in the public service and employees for promotion or transfer shall be based on merit, with a view to developing a public service staffed by competent, well-qualified employees.

Appointment

4. The appointment of a person to a position in the public service shall be effective on the date specified in the instrument appointing that person.

Probation

5. (1) A recommendation by a Department head for the extension of an employee's probationary period as provided under the Ordinance shall be made to the Commissioner not less than two weeks prior to the end of that employee's probationary period.
- (2) Where an employee's probationary period has been extended by the Commissioner, the Department head shall forthwith notify the employee in writing of the Commissioner's decision.

Period of Employment

6. Casual employees shall not be employed beyond six months, but with the approval of the Commissioner the period of employment may be extended to twelve months.
7. A Department head may with the approval of the Commissioner release a part-time, casual or seasonal employee where the work is no longer required or for cause.

Hours of Work

8. (1) The standard hours of work in respect of clerical staff employees shall be 7 1/2 hours per day, 37 1/2 hours per week.
- (2) The standard hours of work in respect of employees other than clerical staff shall be 8 hours per day, 40 hours per week.
9. Where, in the opinion of the Commissioner the nature of the work necessitates an irregular distribution of the employee's hours of work, the Commissioner may average the standard hours of work over a period of up to one year.
10. The Department head shall prescribe the hours of work of the part-time employees in his Department.

Overtime and Holidays

11. (1) A Department head may require an employee to work in excess of the daily or weekly standard hours or on a holiday, where in his opinion the workload so requires.
- (2) Where an employee, other than a manager or a professional, is required to work 1/2 hour or more in excess of the daily or weekly standard hours, he shall be paid for the overtime at 1-1/2 times his regular rate of pay.

- (3) Where an employee, other than a manager or a professional, is required to work on a holiday, he shall be paid, in addition to his regular remuneration for that holiday, at a rate of 1-1/2 times his regular rate of pay.
- (4) Employees shall be paid for overtime in the month following the month in which the overtime was worked.
12. Subject to these regulations, every employee is entitled to a leave of absence with pay on the days declared to be holidays for the public service in the Public Service Ordinance.
13. A casual employee shall not receive a holiday with pay until he has been continuously employed for a period of at least 30 days.
14. When a holiday falls on a non working day, the employee shall be granted a day's leave of absence with pay in lieu thereof, at a time authorized by the Commissioner.
15. Where a person ceases to be an employee, he shall be paid for any overtime or work on a holiday to which he is entitled under section 10 or 12.

Attendance

16. (1) Registers shall be kept to record the attendance of all employees.
- (2) The register shall be signed
- (a) once per month by employees with a salary of over \$10,000 per year or persons employed in a management capacity;
 - (b) once per day by employees with a salary of over \$6,000 per year or who have completed at least ten years of satisfactory service with the public service; and
 - (c) for all other employees at the start and completion of each working day.
- (3) Where an employee fails to comply with subsection (2) and is not excused by his supervisor
- (a) for one-half or less, more than twice in any one month or 12 times in any fiscal year; or
 - (b) for more than one-half hour;
- there shall be deducted from that employee's salary 1/2 hour's pay for each 1/2 hour or portion thereof in which he was absent from duty.

Pay

17. When an employee is appointed to a new position in the public service, he shall be paid,
- (a) if the appointment constitutes a promotion, at the nearest rate which gives him a salary increase at least equal to the smallest annual increment of the new position; or
 - (b) if the appointment constitutes a transfer, at the rate nearest to, but not less than, his former rate of pay.
18. A part-time employee shall be paid at the hourly remuneration for his class.
19. A seasonal employee shall be paid the appropriate rate for his class.
20. Acting pay may be paid in accordance with section 17 from the date on which an employee, other than a casual employee, is required to perform the duties of the higher position; but acting pay shall not be paid for a period of less than 2 months.
21. Where an employee is appointed to a position for which he is receiving acting pay, he shall be paid at the rate at which he was being paid acting pay.

Pay Increases

22. Pay increases shall generally become effective on the first day of a month.

LEAVES OF ABSENCEVacation Leave

23. (1) Every employee, other than a casual, a part-time or an employee on retiring leave, is entitled to vacation leave in each fiscal year, for a period equal to one-quarter of the number of days in his work week for each month in which he received his pay for at least twice the number of days in his work week.
- (2) No employee shall be granted earned vacation leave unless he has been an employee for at least 6 months.

- (3) After completing 2 years of continuous service in the public service, an employee is entitled to an additional week of vacation leave and is entitled thereafter to a vacation of four weeks in each fiscal year.
- (4) An employee who has completed 20 years of continuous service in the Public Service of Canada or in the public service or a combined total of both services shall be entitled to five weeks of annual vacation leave each fiscal year.
24. The accumulated service for part-time and casual employees shall be counted towards the twenty-years of continuous service under section 24.
25. A part-time or casual employee shall be granted 4% of his earnings for the fiscal year in lieu of vacation leave.

Sick Leave

26. Where a Department head is satisfied that an employee is unable to perform the duties of his position because of sickness or injury off the job, the Department head may grant the employee
- (a) leave of absence with pay to the extent that the employee has earned sick leave; or
 - (b) leave of absence without pay, where the employee has no earned sick leave.
27. (1) Every employee, other than a casual employee or an employee on retiring leave, is entitled to sick leave at the rate of one-quarter of the number of days in his work week for each calendar month in which he received his pay for at least twice the number of days in his work week.
- (2) Any sick leave granted with pay shall be deducted from the sick leave earned pursuant to subsection (1).
28. No employee shall be granted sick leave during a period in which he is on retiring leave, leave of absence without pay, or under suspension.
29. Before sick leave is granted, the employee shall provide a certificate that he was unable to perform his duties, stating the type of illness, and signed by

- (a) the employee, where the absence does not exceed three days; or
 - (b) a qualified medical practitioner where
 - (i) the absence exceeds three days,
 - (ii) the employee has been granted seven or more days of sick leave in the fiscal year, none of which were certified by a qualified medical practitioner, or
 - (iii) the Department head is of the opinion that such a certificate should be obtained.
30. (1) Where an employee is unable to perform his duties for a continuous period of not less than 3 days because of sickness or injury off the job and has no earned sick leave, the Department head may grant leave of absence with pay for a period not exceeding three weeks if the employee has had at least one year of service and his performance has been satisfactory.
- (2) There shall be deducted from any sick leave subsequently earned by the employee, the amount of any leave of absence with pay granted under subsection (1), and no further sick leave shall be granted until the total amount of leave granted under subsection (1) has been paid back.

Special Leave

31. (1) Every employee, other than a casual employee and an employee on retiring leave, is entitled to special leave up to a maximum of 5 weeks, at the rate of one-half day for each month in which he received his pay for at least twice the number of days in his work week.
- (2) Any special leave granted with pay shall be deducted from the special leave earned pursuant to subsection (1).
32. The Department head may grant an employee special leave with pay for a period of up to 1 week, to the extent that it has been earned, under the following circumstances:
- (a) where a member of the immediate family (which includes father or father-in-law, mother or mother-in-law, brother or sister), becomes ill (not including normal childbirth) and the employee is required to care for his dependants or for the sick person;

- (b) where there is a death in the employee's immediate family;
 - (c) where an employee is to be married;
 - (d) where special circumstances not directly attributable to the employee prevent his reporting for duty, including
 - (i) serious household or domestic emergencies,
 - (ii) a general transportation tie-up caused by weather if the employee makes every reasonable effort to report for duty from his usual residence, but where transportation delays prevent an employee reporting for duty from other than his usual residence, the circumstances may be considered attributable to the employee and the time should be charged to vacation leave or leave without pay, or
 - (iii) serious community emergencies, where the employee is required to render assistance; and
 - (e) for circumstances which are of general value to the public service, such as where the employee
 - (i) takes an examination which will improve his position or qualifications in the public service,
 - (ii) attends his University Convocation, if he has been continuously employed for at least one year,
 - (iii) attends a course in civil defence training, or
 - (iv) requires a medical examination for enlistment in the Armed Forces or in connection with a veteran's treatment program.
33. (1) Special leave in excess of one week may only be granted with the Commissioner's approval.
- (2) Special leave shall not be granted to an employee who is on retiring leave, on leave of absence without pay or under suspension.

Educational Leave

34. Educational leave shall be based on an appraisal of the present and future job requirements and the qualifications of the employee applying therefor and shall be granted only to meet identified needs.

35. (1) Educational leave may be recommended by the Department head and shall be approved by the Commissioner.
- (2) Full pay, tuition, travelling and other expenses may be granted during educational leave
- (a) where the employee has become technically obsolete and requires retraining to satisfactorily carry out the work;
 - (b) where the educational courses are required to keep the employee abreast of new knowledge and techniques in his field of work; or
 - (c) where qualified persons cannot be recruited to carry out essential work and it is necessary to train present employees.
- (3) Partial pay, tuition, travelling and other expenses may be granted during educational leave where the course is of value to the work and will develop the general ability and potential of the employees concerned. The extent of payment will depend on an assessment of the courses' value to the work.
- (4) Refund of tuition fees, in respect of courses may be made on receipt of evidence of successful completion, if the course is of value to the employee's work and does not require the employee to be absent from duties.
- (5) Educational leave with full pay will carry with it the obligation to return after leave to work in the north for one calendar year for each academic year of leave.

Court Leave

36. The Department head shall grant every employee, other than a casual employee or an employee on leave of absence without pay, retirement leave or under suspension, leave with pay for such time as is necessary and reasonable
- (a) to serve on jury;
 - (b) to attend as a witness before a body authorized by law to compel the attendance of witnesses; or
 - (c) to participate in the grievance procedure as an appellant.

Retiring Leave

37. (1) An employee who is about to cease to be employed in the public service and who is a lay-off or will be eligible for an immediate annuity under the Public Service Superannuation Act, may be granted retiring leave for a period not in excess of 26 weeks calculated at the rate of one week for each completed year of continuous employment in the public service minus any retiring leave, or gratuity in lieu thereof, previously granted.
- (2) Where the employee so requests, a gratuity may be granted in lieu of retiring leave which is calculated by multiplying the retiring leave earned under subsection (1) by the employee's final weekly remuneration and subtracting therefrom the amount of annuity he is entitled to under the Public Service Superannuation Act for the period of retiring leave.
- (3) An employee, other than an employee described in subsection (1) or one who is dismissed or abandons his position, may be granted a gratuity equal to the number of weeks, not in excess of thirteen, calculated at the rate of one-half week for each completed year of continuous employment in the public service minus any retiring leave, or gratuity in lieu thereof, previously granted.
- (4) For the purpose of subsection (3), the times of service for part-time and seasonal employees shall be counted towards continuous employment.
38. Retiring leave, or a gratuity in lieu thereof, shall not be granted to an employee who has been continuously employed in the public service for a period of less than four years.

Injury-On-Duty-Leave

39. A Department head may grant leave of absence with pay to an employee who is unable to perform the duties of his position because of
- (a) personal injury accidentally received in the performance of his duties and not caused by the employee's wilful misconduct; or

(b) sickness arising out of and during the course of his employment;

if that employee agrees to pay the Government of the Northwest Territories any amount received by him for loss of wages in settlement of any Workmen's Compensation claim he may have in respect thereof.

Leave Without Pay

40. A Department head may in his discretion grant leave of absence without pay for a period of up to six months; but additional leave of absence without pay requires approval by the Commissioner.

Travel Leave

41. (1) Every employee who is proceeding on vacation or sick leave may, with the approval of the Commissioner, be granted leave of absence with pay for the lesser of three days or the actual time taken to travel from his post to a point of departure and return.
- (2) For the purposes of subsection (1), "point of departure" means Edmonton, Winnipeg, Ottawa or Montreal.

Grievances

42. Any employee grievance other than one involving demotion, suspension, or dismissal, may be processed through the formal grievance procedure as provided for under section 45 of these Regulations providing that the employee has first made a reasonable attempt to solve his problem with his immediate supervisor.
43. Prior to submitting a complaint through the formal grievance procedure, the employee may seek advice from an employee's association or a personnel administrator.
44. Employees have the prerogative of presenting their grievances personally or through a representative.
45. The grievance procedure is described below:
- Step 1: The employee shall submit his grievance in writing describing the nature of his complaint to his immediate supervisor within 5 working days after the circumstances giving rise to the grievance. The decision of the supervisor shall be given in writing within 5 working days from receipt of the grievance.

Step 2: If the employee is not satisfied with the decision given under Step 1 and wishes to proceed further, he shall within a period of 5 working days, submit his grievance in writing to his Department head. A meeting shall subsequently be held with the employee, or his representative, and the Department head and a written reply shall be given, by the Department head, within 5 working days of receipt of the grievance.

Step 3: If agreement has still not been reached and the employee wishes to proceed to Step 3 of the grievance procedure he shall present his grievance in writing within 5 working days to the Commissioner who shall appoint a committee of senior officers of the Government of the Northwest Territories. This committee shall investigate the grievance and hear the employee (and his representative) following which the committee shall submit a confidential report to the Commissioner within 5 working days of receipt of the grievance. The Commissioner shall then give his decision which shall be final and binding.

46. By mutual agreement of both parties to the grievance, the time limits for each stage of the grievance procedure may be extended.

47. An employee who claims that he has been unjustly demoted, suspended or dismissed may appeal to the Commissioner as provided under section 25 to 29 of the Public Service Ordinance.

General

48. Where the Commissioner is unable to satisfy himself as to the reason an employee is absent without leave, the Commissioner shall not declare the employee to have abandoned his position until the employee has been absent for at least 1 month, or if the circumstances are known, the employee may be declared to have abandoned his position after 1 week's absence without leave as provided under the Ordinance.

49. No employee shall carry on any business or employment outside the Public Service in which :

- (a) he exploits unduly and for personal gain his acquaintance with other employees or with persons with whom he has become acquainted in the course of his employment in the public service;
- (b) there may be a conflict between the duties the employee is required to perform in that business or employment and the duties he is required to perform in the public service; or
- (c) he makes unauthorized use of information he has acquired as a result of his employment in the public service or of property or facilities owned by Her Majesty in the right of Canada or the Government of the Northwest Territories.

REGULATIONS MADE PURSUANT TO THE PUBLIC SERVICE ORDINANCEShort Title

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service Regulations.

Interpretation

2. (1) In these regulations,

(a) "casual employee" means a person engaged to perform work of a casual nature or in an emergency;

(b) "demotion" means the appointment of an employee to a new position, the maximum rate of pay of which is less than that of his former position;

(c) "Department Head" means an employee reporting directly to the Commissioner who is responsible for the operation of a major organization unit within the public service;

(d) "grievance" means a complaint that an employee, group of employees or a recognized employees association submits to management, to be processed through the grievance procedure;

(e) "manager" means an employee responsible for planning, organizing, co-ordinating, directing and controlling the use of men, material and money;

(f) "part-time employee" means a person employed on a continuing basis for less than the standard work day, week or month;

(g) "promotion" means the appointment of an employee to a new position, the maximum rate of pay of which exceeds that of his former position by at least

(i) the smallest pay increase of the new position, or

(ii) a percent of the maximum rate of pay of the former position where the new position has only one rate of pay;

(h) "professional" means an employee engaged in work where there is a requirement for a highly developed or specialized body of knowledge acquired through university education;

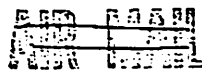
