Cambridge Bay, N.W.T.,

We, the people of Cambridge Bay, wish to advise the authorities in Ottawa that we would like the children in grades seven and eight to have the opportunity of attending school here in Cambridge Bay this coming term (September, 1968). At present these children have no alternative but to attend school in Inuvik.

Now that Cambridge Bay has the added facility of a new school, we strongly feel our children should not be subjected to leaving home at such an early age.

We eskimo parents especially feel these children are too young and immature to be separated from parental influence and home environment. Many people have been disappointed at the undesirable influence the large centre of Inuvik has had on young children. These things cause undue worry and concern for both them and us.

Also, extending the educational facilities will help promote more white families to remain longer in the settlement thus giving more continuity to our community.

We fully realize some specialized courses of a larger school may not be available here now, but we are still convinced it is definitely advantageous for our children to attend school locally.

We thank you for your attention. Please do not just listen to this letter---do something to help us and allow our children to receive grade seven and eight instruction here in Cambridge Bay this fall.
