TELEX MESSAGE FROM SPENCE BAY COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

An emergency meeting of the Spence Bay Community Association unanimously registered its deep concern over a wire informing residents that the housing programme for 1968 has been deferred for another year. The residents also expressed concern that this failure of the government to honour its committment means another year of dirt, disease, cold and conditions that would not be tolerated under any circumstances in any other country in the world.
