COMPLIMENTARY HUNTING LICENCE

Complimentary hunting licences are issued to visiting dignitaries for specific animals in designated areas, subject to Order in Council regarding mammals in danger of extinction. Such licences, issued in the provinces by the minister responsible for game management, have added to the prestige of provincial governments and have become valuable instruments of good will.

Because the Territorial Government is assuming more and more responsibilities of a provincial nature, and because increasing numbers of businessmen and government officials are expected to visit the Northwest Territories, giving the Commissioner the opportunity to make use of such a licence, it is considered advisable that a Complimentary Hunting Licence be created.

Recommendation

The Commissioner therefore recommends that the following provisions for a Complimentary Hunting Licence be inserted in "Appendix A" of the Game Ordinance:
