

N.W.T. Flag

The Flag Committee set up at the 36th Session of Council plan to achieve the objective i.e. have an N.W.T. Flag raised on all flag poles in and throughout the N.W.T. on the Centennial Anniversary Date i.e. June 23 1970

1. Conduct a competition throughout the N.W.T. directed primarily toward the school population -- but not limited to any Canadian citizen.
2. To advertise the competition in all N.W.T. papers.
3. Advise the principals of all N.W.T. Schools.
4. The competition to be completed and the design selected by the committee to be recommended to the next Session of Council.
5. That (a) the winner be recognized by an award to a value of approximately \$1500 -- The actual award to be one of suitable use for the recipient. i.e. A student award be a trip to Ottawa for one week accompanied by mother.
(b) The 2nd and 3rd prizes may be \$500 and \$300 prizes.


6. In order to effect the foregoing, we require your consent to a budget of around \$2500 to \$3000 plus mailing and typing services.
