STUDENTS LEAVING N.W.T. SCHOOLS BETWEEN
SEPTEMBER 1962 and JUNE 1967

The attached survey shows that 1,573 students left N.W.T. Schools in the five year period covered. Of this number, 249 are either unable to work or could not be located. An additional 435 females are at home either with their parents or husbands, and 98 students are in some other education or training program. This leaves a potential labour force of 791, of whom 179 are in trapping and/or casual labour, 488 are in full time employment and 200 are unemployed.

The low average grade achieved by students prior to leaving schools in some of the settlements largely reflects their late entry date into the schools. This situation is slowly being rectified as our Department of Education seeks to ensure that all children will begin school at age six or seven.
