The community council of Igloolik held a meeting, trying to get the different opinions of the people about having a high school in Frobisher Bay and sending their children there. The majority of the people don't agree on sending their children away to Frobisher Bay. It can change the lives of these children and if there are too many from different places put into one place without their parent's guidance, they can become very difficult. On returning home later, they might not want to listen to their parents at all. All parents want their children to get the best of everything, education, jobs and many other things. And a child who can obey and who is well looked after can have a much better life when grown. They, the parents, think that when a child is away from home and parents, he can forget what he had been taught.

We are not trying to stop the school completely. What we are trying to say is that, if the number of children is too great, all in one place, it would not be too good for them. Perhaps more than one school, built in different settlements, would be better.

In this way the children would be able to go to the nearest high school from his home. But the lack of air strips is the only the problem.

This letter may not get any notice but we only want to bring out the ideas of parents concerning their children about going to high school in Frobisher Bay. And we want an answer. It seems that the government had not cared about the people's ideas. They have not asked before, if the people would want a high school in Frobisher Bay. They had thought only of their own ideas. We are anxious to get letters from anyone.

Because it was impossible to have all the people of Igloolik to write, we have had them signed indicating they don't want to send their children away.
