Dear Duncan,

Just to let you know that I'll not be able to be at your meeting "the Event of the year" next week. I'll be on my way south to join the Continuing Education Division of the University of Calgary ^{down} on the 15th of June — so alas, I must send my regrets.

There is just no way that anyone that is community development - adult education oriented can survive within this Educational system. The setting is geared to classrooms, teachers, and curriculum within the school setting. If I kept to neat learning programs, everyone would be happy. Unfortunately, I happen to believe that people must be involved in looking at their lives and the forces determining the direction their lives are taking and then structuring themselves to bring about to more equitable conditions. This is what democracy is all about — and I believe its very much a concern of Adult Education. I think the kind of thing we tried to do with Coulter & Marnell has real significance, as does Frontier College. Yet these two programs have met with unshakable resistance. Why was the Coulter, Marnell report held up for over two months? Its an excellent report and should have received wide circulation. Its to the Communities credit that he eventually decided to release the report, much

to the dismay of some Civil Servants within the Education Dept.

Frontier College is an excellent program, yet the resistance this is receiving is unbelievable. Our two pilot projects in Smith & Resolution did wonders for many of the participants. Frontier College is willing to send teams to 13-14 different settlements ^{in N.W.T.} and Grangpauer will not only foot the bill, but will pay the students a living wage as well. If 75% of jobs are to go to Northerners we better start with a crash program to upgrade and prepare people for employment. The Vocational Director is just now saying "We must concentrate on the youth, there nothing that can be done for the older, welfare oriented heads of households". I say crap, we have no right to wipe out a generation, the very generation that are the parents of the youth that the V.O.C. Ed. Division are so keen on. Just look at the jails, the correctional institutions, the magistrates courts and see what's happening. Pretty sad. But what alternatives have these kids. I talked to a "leading" young Metis the other day, a product of this Educational system. His assessment! "I'm better because I've got more white blood than treaty Indians." God, here's a young intelligent kid who is a "success" and he's ashamed of being Indian (part).

At a meeting five weeks ago, to discuss the future of Frontier College, the Regional Directors of Education were gathered to evaluate and make judgement on the success/failure of Frontier College. We invited several Indian people (much against the wishes of some of the First people) to sit in. I couldn't believe the naive, uninformed, stupid questions that these top education decision makers were asking. These high paid experts just aren't equipped to cope with the special educational needs of Northeners. They are nice people, but certainly not knowledgeable about the Indian and Eskimo. Yet they are the leaders - the ones who will bring lightness to these shores.

So I'm leaving. Really being forced out. Talk to Echo Liddle about the details. I've already gone on far too long. This little note started out as an apology as to why I couldn't be at your wedding. It ended up as a soul bearing session. Feel free to use any of these views as you see fit. Like:

What special qualifications do the Regional Asst. have to develop policies affecting Indians & Eskimos?

- Why was the Gauley-Mann report held up?
- Will Frontier College go ahead?
- Will Adult Education continue to be under School Dept? (totally ineffective as change oriented programs seem held out of Administration)

May I wish you and Georgia all
the happiness possible and wish you
continued success in your "swinging" efforts
to swing some significant change up here.
