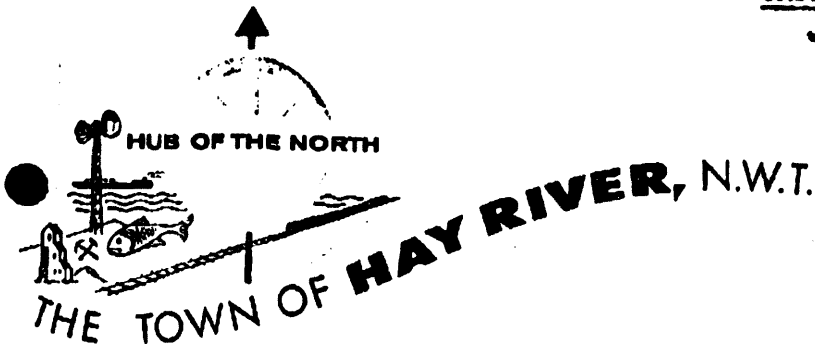

EXCERPT FROM COUNCIL MINUTES - REGULAR MEETING, JANUARY 19, 1970
TOWN OF HAY RIVER

Fuel Oil Tax

WHEREAS the Government of the Northwest Territories levies a fuel oil tax of three cents (3¢) per gallon on all fuel oil; and

WHEREAS most northern communities are supplied with electricity by diesel generating plants; and

WHEREAS some northern communities are served by private power companies which pay a fuel oil tax of three cents (3¢) per gallon; and

WHEREAS other northern communities are served by the Government Power Commission which is exempted from paying the fuel oil tax; and

WHEREAS most buildings and houses in northern communities are heated by fuel oil or propane which is subject to the levy of three cents (3¢) per gallon tax.

NOWHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Town of Hay River request Territorial Councillor D. M. Stewart to press the Territorial Government to remove the three cents (3¢) per gallon fuel oil tax on fuel used for domestic heating and for power generating.
