SCHEDULE OF AMENDMENTS TO THE GAME REGULATIONS.

The Regulations respecting the conservation of game made pursuant to Commissioner's Order 40-67 dated April 28, 1967, are amended as follows:

- 1. Section 6 of the said Regulations is revoked and the following is substituted therefor:
 - "6. The holder of a buffalo licence may hunt buffalo in Game Management Zones 3 and 5 from September 15th to December 31st next following."
- 2. The said Regulations are amended by adding thereto, immediately after Section 6 thereof, the following section:
 - "6A. The holder of a polar bear licence may, in the company of a licenced guide who has a valid and subsisting polar bear tag, hunt polar bear in Game Management Zones 25 to 27, 29 to 35 and 37 from October 1st to May 31st next following."
- 3. Section 7 of the said Regulations is amended by adding thereto, immediately after subsection (h) thereof, the following subsections:
 - "(i) subject to section 6, one buffalo of any age and sex in Game Management Zones 3 and 5; and
 - (j) subject to sections 6A and 36, one polar bear in Game Management Zones 25 to 27, 29 to 35 and 37."
 - 4. Section 9 of the said Regulations is revoked.
- 5. Section 22 of the said Regulations is renumbered to read Section 22(1) and the following subsection is added, immediately following subsection (1) thereof:
 - "(2) The holder of a valid and subsisting polar bear tag, when acting as a guide to the holder of a polar bear licence, shall transfer his polar bear tag to the holder of such polar bear licence."

- 6. The said Regulations are further amended by adding thereto, immediately after section 33 thereof, the following sections:
 - "34. (1) Every licence to capture and export live big game and live predatory animals shall state
 - (a) the area or location of capture;
 - (b) the age and sex of the species of animal to be captured;
 - (c) the number of each species to be captured; and
 - (d) the period of time during which the animals may be captured.
 - (2) The holder of a licence described in subsection(1) shall effect capture of animals only in accordance withthe terms of the ordinance, these Regulations and his licence.
 - (3) The Government of the Northwest Territories is not responsible for any of the costs incurred by the holder of a licence described in subsection (1).
 - 35. (1) Birds of prey may be captured only in Game Management Zones 25 to 27, 29 and 30 to 33, and only by a game officer or a person under the supervision of a game officer.
 - (2) The capture of peregrine falcons is prohibited. Any such birds captured accidentally must be released immediately.
 - (3) The fee for a bird of prey is:

 Gyrfalcon \$1,000.00
 - (4) The responsibility of the Government of the Northwest Territories to the purchaser ceases on delivery of the live bird to the transportation company.
 - 36. (1) The holder of a polar bear licence may not hunt polar bear with young or young polar bear which are accompanying an adult polar bear.
 - (2) The holder of a polar bear licence must take all reasonable means of killing a polar bear which he has wounded.

- 3 -(3) A valid and subsisting polar bear tag shall be affixed to the polar bear hide immediately the animal has been skinned. Schedule A 7. Schedule A of the said Regulations is amended by adding thereto, immediately after the description of Game Management Zone 36 the following: "Game Management Zone 37 In the Northwest Territories: All that portion of the Keewatin District lying within the boundaries described as follows: Commencing at the ordinary low water mark at the extremity of the most southerly point on Nottingham Island; Thence southerly in a straight line to the ordinary low water mark at the extremity of the most northerly point of Cape Wolstenholme; Thence southerly following the ordinary low water mark of the east shore of Hudson Bay and encompassing all of the off-shore islands to the ordinary low water mark at the western extremity of Cape Jones; Thence southerly, westerly and northerly following the boundaries of the James Bay Preserve as described in Schedule F of the Game Ordinance, and including the Twin Islands Game Sanctuary as described in Schedule G of the Game Ordinance, to the ordinary low water mark at the northern extremity of Cape Henrietta Maria; Thence northerly in a straight line to the ordinary low water mark at the southern extremity of Cary's Swan Nest; Thence northeasterly in a straight line to the point of commencement; All being described with reference to the latest appropriate map sheets of the National Topographic system on scales of 8 miles to 1 inch and 1:500,000 available on the 1st day of November, 1969."

REGULATIONS PRESCRIBING LIMITATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS ON THE DIMENSIONS AND WEIGHT OF ANY VEHICLE OR COMBINATION OF VEHICLES OPERATING ON A HIGHWAY

1. These regulations may be cited as the <u>Vehicles Dimension</u> and <u>Weight Limits Regulations</u>.

Dimensions

- 2. No person shall operate on a highway a vehicle
 - (a) the overall width of which exceeds
 - (i) ten feet in the case of a mobile home or similar vehicle, or
 - (ii) eight feet six inches (one hundred and two inches), in any other case;
 - (b) the overall height of which, including its load exceeds thirteen feet six inches;

- (c) the overall length of which, including its load, exceeds
 - (i) forty feet in the case of a single vehicle; or
 - (ii) sixty-five feet in the case of a combination of vehicles:
- (d) the load of which protrudes

- (i) more than three feet in front of the vehicle; or
- (ii) more than fifteen feet to the rear from the centre of the rear-most axle of the vehicle; or
- (1ii) from either side of the vehicle.

Weights

- 3. No vehicle or combination of vehicles shall be so loaded that the weight on any axle of that vehicle or combination of vehicles exceeds
 - (a) eighteen thousand pounds where the axles are spaced more than ten feet apart;
 - (b) sixteen thousand pounds where the axles are spaced no less than forty-two inches and no more than ten feet apart; or
 - (c) nine thousand pounds where the axles are spaced less than forty-two inches apart.
- 4. (1) No vehicle including its load shall weigh in excess of
 - (a) twenty-seven thousand pounds if the vehicle is equipped with two axles; or
 - (b) forty-one thousand pounds if the vehicle is equipped with three axles.
 - (2) No combination of vehicles shall weigh in excess of
 - (a) forty-five thousand pounds if the combination of vehicles is equipped with three axles;
 - (b) fifty-six thousand pounds if the combination of vehicles is equipped with four axles; or
 - (c) seventy-two thousand pounds if the combination of vehicles is equipped with more than four axles.
- 5. No vehicle or combination of vehicles shall be so loaded that the weight on any wheel of that vehicle or combination of vehicles exceeds six hundred pounds per lineal inch of width of tire.

- 6. (1) Notwithstanding Sections 2, 3, 4 or 5, the holder of a permit issued by the Registrar of Vehicles may operate a vehicle of the dimensions, weight or weight distribution authorized by such permit.
- (2) A holder of a permit issued by the Registrar of Vehicles shall comply with all the terms of such permit.
- 7. The Registrar of Vehicles may, where conditions warrant it,
 - (a) increase the weight limits prescribed in these regulations by not more than five per cent;
 - (b) close any highway or restrict the period during which a highway, or part thereof may be used; or
 - (c) reduce the weight limits prescribed in these regulations.
- 8. (1) The Registrar of Vehicles may establish weigh scales at such locations on a highway as he considers necessary and shall cause signs to be erected in the vicinity of such weigh scales requiring that a vehicle be stopped for the purpose of determining its weight.
- (2) If the weight of any vehicle determined in accordance with subsection (1) exceeds the weight permitted by these regulations for that vehicle, the driver of the vehicle shall not return the vehicle to the highway until its load is reduced or redistributed so that the weight of the vehicle and the distribution thereof comply with these regulations.
- (3) Any driver of a vehicle to whom a sign erected pursuant to subsection (1) applies, shall comply with the requirements of such sign.
- 9. These regulations do not apply to any vehicle engaged upon the work of maintenance of a highway.

CHANGE OF NAME ORDINANCE FINANCIAL ADMINISTRATION ORDINANCE
