- 1. In these Regulations
- (a) "application" means the application referred to in section 3;
- (b) "articled clerk" means a person who becomes an articled clerk pursuant to these regulations;
- (c) "articles of clerkship" means the articles of clerkship set out in Form 3:
- (d) "Director" means the Director of the Department of Legal Affairs.
- 2. The Director shall, on the behalf of the Commissioner, approve articles of clerkship and administer these regulations.
- 3. A person who applies to be articled to a barrister and solicitor in the Territories shall furnish the Director with
 - (a) an application in Form 1 of the Schedule;
 - (b) two certificates in good character from reputable persons in Form 2 of the Schedule;
 - (c) articles of clerkship in Form 3 of the Schedule duly executed in triplicate;
 - (d) proof from the proper authority that the applicant
 - (i) is a graduate of a law school in Canada, or
 - (ii) has been duly called to the bar of England, Scotland, Northern Ireland, New Zealand or Australia or is a solicitor, advocate or writer to the signet in any of Her Majesty's courts therein;

and

- (e) a fee of ten dollars.
- 4. When the Director has approved the application, the term of service under the articles of clerkship shall be one year commencing on the day upon which the articled clerk has duly complied with all the requirements of the Legal Profession Ordinance and of these regulations or on such earlier date as the Commissioner may approve.

- 5. (1) The principal named in the articles of clerkship referred to in section 3 may, with the concurrence of the Director and the articled clerk named therein, assign the articles of clerkship to another duly qualified principal who has agreed to assume the duties and obligations set out in the articles of clerkship.
- (2) The assignment referred to in subsection (1) shall be delivered to the Director promptly and, subject to compliance with the provisions of subsection (1), shall take effect from the date of such delivery.
 - $\underline{6.}$ (1) If the principal to whom an articled clerk is articled (a) dies;
 - (b) has his name struck from the roll or suspended from practice as a result of disciplinary proceedings; or
 - (c) ceases to be actively engaged in the practice of law in the Territories during the term of the articles of clerkship;

such articles of clerkship shall thereupon terminate.

- (2) If a principal is found guilty of conduct unbecoming a barrister or solicitor, the articles of clerkship may, if it is in the interest of the articled clerk, be terminated.
- (3) An articled clerk may, upon notice to his principal, apply to the Director to be relived from his articles of clerkship and upon hearing the matter, the Director may, if in his judgment it is in the interest of the articled clerk to do so, terminate the articles.
- (4) Where an articles of clerkship have been terminated under this section, the articled clerk may enter into new articles of clerkship and in that event he shall be allowed the whole or such part of service under the original articles as the Director may determine having regard to all the circumstances.
- (5) When new articles are entered into under this section, no fee in respect thereof is payable by the articled clerk.

7. Where any barrister and solicitor, articled clerk or other person is dissatisfied with a decision of the Director pursuant to any provision of these Regulations, the barrister and solicitor, articled clerk or other persons may appeal the decision to the Commissioner.

1. The attached Ras Development Area Regulations are hereby made and established.

REGULATIONS RESPECTING THE RAE DEVELOPMENT AREA

Short Title

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Rae Development Area Regulations.

Interpretation

- 2. In these Regulations,
- (a) "Area Control Officer" means the person appointed pursuant to subsection 5(1) of the Ordinance to administer and enforce the Ordinance and these Regulations;
- (b) "Ordinance" means the Area Development Ordinance; and
- (c) "Rae Development Area" means the area designated as a development area pursuant to section 3.
- 3. The area described in the Schedule hereto is designated as a development area and shall be known as the Rae Development Area.
- 4. (1) Except with the permission of the Area Control Officer, no person shall, within the Rae Development Area,
 - (a) erect, move or alter any building or structure; and
 - (b) make any excavation or disturb the surface of the ground for construction purposes.
- (2) Paragraph (1)(a) does not apply to the repair or any minor alteration of a building or structure that does not change the use of such building or structure.

Approval is secured when 60% of the voters exercising their voting rights on this question respond in favour of the proposal. The Davelopment Area of Rae-Edzo is defined, pursuant to the Area Development Ordinance, as:

"All that portion of land lying within the following boundaries: commencing at latitude 62 degrees 42 minutes north and longitude 116 degrees 10 minutes west, thence due north to latitude 62 degrees 51 minutes north, thence due east to 115 degrees 50 minutes west, thence due south to latitude 62 degrees 42 minutes north, thence due west to the point of commencement".

The following questions will be presented on the ballot and affirmative or negative responses are to be indicated by an "X" in the space provided on the ballot form after "YES" or "NO":

Are you in favour of the sale of beer only under a beer parlour licence for consumption on licensed premises?

Are you in favour of the sale of liquor under a dining lounge licence for consumption with meals on licensed premises?

Are you in favour of the sale of liquor under a cocktail lounge licence for consumption on licenced premises?

Are you in favour of the sale or consumption of liquor under a special licence?

Are you in favour of the sale of liquor through government operated or controlled liquor stores?
