Annual Report of Territorial Accounts - 1969-70

The report of Territorial Accounts for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1970 is contained herein in accordance with the requirements of Section 35 of the Financial Administration Act.

The working capital position of the Government was invaded significantly during 1969-70 to cover the deficit voted in Main Estimates and unfunded Supplementary Estimates. As reflected in Schedule 6, the working capital declined from \$3,850,061 to \$2,680,916. It should be a matter of some priority to rebuild the working capital to a level of at least \$3,500,000 to meet the normal operating requirements of the Government.

Revenue production within the N.W.T. continued to run slightly higher than expected with fuel taxes, vehicle licenses and investment interest showing the largest gains.

As the Government assumes responsibility for the Eastern Arctic, Administration of Justice, Workmen's Compensation and other functions in 1970-71, the budget and level of operations will again grow significantly over the year covered by this report. Increased fiscal responsibility will fall squarely upon the Administration and the Council as the annual spending of the Government approaches \$75,000,000.

Notes to Financial Statements as at March 31, 1970

1. Capital Assets

Capital assets purchased by the Government of the Northwest Territories are recorded at cost. Assets acquired by transfer from the Federal Government are recorded at a current valuation based upon a fair market value.

2. Federal Advance - Northern Housing Program

Advances totalling \$905,500 were received during the fiscal year ended March 31, 1970, for the operation and maintenance of the Federal northern housing program for Indians and Eskimos.

No accounting has yet been made of expenditures made against these advances since the Territorial Government's records do not identify the related costs separately.

A liability to the Federal Government for unused funds may exist but the amount, if any, cannot be determined until a final claim has been prepared and submitted.

3. Contingent Liability - Fishermen's Loans

The Government of the Northwest Territories has guaranteed payment of commercial bank loans to certain fishermen for the purchase of boats and equipment. The amount outstanding at March 31, 1970 was \$135,399.
