Dear Mr. Hodgson:

Thank you for your letter of January 25, 1971.

This week our National Services Secretary, Mrs. K. J. C. Dean will be writing to Dr. G. C. Butler about the first I.O.D.E. incubators to go to the Northwest Territories.

The project Operation Incubators was given formal approval at the February 3rd meeting of the National Executive Committee. The Transport Incubator (\$1,200.00) for Fort Rae was given by the National Services Department. The Municipal Chapter of Saskatoon will furnish the first Nursing Incubator (\$400.00) for Holman Island Nursing Station. Promises have been made for others and the funds should be received within the month. In this way a new project is opened gradually.

The Provincial Chapter of Ontario will send a Nursing Incubator to Watson Lake Nursing Station in the Yukon and so the project will commence in the Territories simultaneously.

This note will alert you that Operation Incubators is off the ground. Let us hope it has clear flying ahead.
