Dear Sir:

On 28 December 71, the Town Council of Inuvik passed a Resolution to request you as N.W.T. Councillor to seek municipal and N.W.T. Government assistance to obtain an operating Grant from the Northwest Territories Government which would assist in the financing of operations relating to Municipally operated Community Centres.

Enclosed herewith is an estimated revenue forecast for the Inuvik Community Centre Project along with an estimated expenditure forecast based on estimates from other Communities.


The total estimated operating expenditure for a twelve month period including light, heat, supervision, maintenance and general administration are expected to be in the area of \$65,000.00 therefore creating a deficit

of 27,600.00.

As you can see by the figures quoted herein a deficit of this amount is not feasible economically for a town of this size and any action you are able to initiate to have a Northwest Territories operating Grant implemented would be greatly appreciated by the residents of the Town of Inuvik as well as other Communities who are now facing a similar problem in providing a most necessary service to the General Public such as Recreation.
