NOTICE OF PLANNED

EXPLORATION ACTIVITY

COMPANY:

Western Decalta Petroleum Ltd.

DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM:

The company has applied for a Land Use Operation involving the provision of an access route, campsite and wellsite for the purpose of moving in and supporting equipment required to drill an exploratory well for oil and/or gas on Permit No. 5518.

Initially, access will be on the Mackenzie River itself from the Dahadinni stockpile site to a point just north of the mouth of the Johnson River, thus will not involve a Land Use Operation. From this point, existing seismic cutlines will be used as an access route to one of the proposed wellsites (labelled Site 1 and Site 2 on the attached map). If the second site is chosen as the location to drill, the total land access will be approximately 19 miles and comprise about 76 acres.

Approximately 26 men will be employed by the contractor Guthrie-McLaren Drilling Ltd.

TIMING:

Start clearing this month and finish program by September 30, 1973.
