Thank you for your letter regarding payment of supplementary allowances to persons on fixed incomes in the N.W.T.

I suggest the difficulties experienced by pensioners and the like are so urgent as to be attended to without waiting for Council to convene and approve your administration's action. My purpose in copying all other Council members with my request was so that your administrative people could take action along the lines requested last October in Frobisher Bay and present to Council at Inuvik supplementary estimates to cover additional monies being paid to pensioners.

I trust that your "firm answer" in October will be to the effect that such supplementary estimates as requested have been developed and a program implemented.
