PRESENTED ON May 19, 1976

At the request of Bryan Pearson we have agreed to assemble a petition indicating the support of our community for retaining a Baffin section of the Teacher Education Programme in Frobisher Bay next year.

If the plan to have this section of the course moved to Fort Smith were successful, it would mean very few Inuit from the Baffin Region would want to enter the course. This would probably mean that almost no Inuit teachers would be qualified to teach our children in Frobisher Bay in the next few years. Every teacher at our school is strongly in favour of continuing the present programme in Frobisher Bay at least one more year.

You are strongly encouraged to sign this petition to indicate that you want the present Teacher Education Programme to remain in Frobisher Bay next year.

This petition will be presented to our Village Council on or before 4 p.m. Thursday, May 6, 1976.
