IN THE LAND FREEZE PROPOSAL SUBMITTED BY COPE ON BEHALF OF TUKTOY-  
AKTUK YOU STATED THAT EXPLORATION ACTIVITIES IN THIS AREA (INCLUDING  
HUSKY LAKES LIVERPOOL BAY AND BATHURST PENINSULA TO APPROXIMATELY  
68 DEGREES 30') WOULD INTERFERE WITH HUNTING FISHING AND  
TRAPPING

THE PROBLEMS RAISED WITH RESPECT TO THE KENDALL ISLAND BIRD  
SANCTUARY AND THE PROTECTION OF THE MIGRATION ROUTE OF WHALES  
I UNDERSTAND HAVE BEEN RESOLVED

THIS LEAVES AN AREA IN WHICH CONTINUED DISCUSSIONS HAVE NOT PROD-  
UCED AGREEMENT

YOU HAVE ASKED THAT FURTHER EXPLORATION ACTIVITY BE HALTED UNTIL  
THE LAND CLAIMS FOR THE DELTA ARE SETTLED

WHILE I CANNOT ACCEPT A TOTAL FREEZE ON DEVELOPMENT RELATED ACTIVITY  
I CAN AGREE THAT ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROLS ON THIS TYPE OF ACTIVITY  
SHOULD BE ADEQUATE TO ENSURE THE CONTINUED USE OF THE AREA FOR  
TRADITIONAL PURSUITS SUCH AS HUNTING FISHING AND TRAPPING  
THERE HAS BEEN A GREAT DEAL OF CONFLICTING INFORMATION AND VIEWPOINTS  
AS TO WHETHER EXISTING CONTROLS ARE ADEQUATE FOR THIS PURPOSE  
THERE IS A FURTHER QUESTION AS TO WHICH SPECIFIC AREAS ARE OF  
GREATEST INTEREST TO TUKTOYAKTUK RESIDENTS INCLUDING HUNTERS AND  
TRAPPERS IN TERMS OF PROTECTING THEIR TRADITIONAL ACTIVITIES ON  
THE LAND

ON DECEMBER 8/76 THE DEPT RECEIVED AN APPLICATION FROM GULF OIL  
TO UNDERTAKE A SMALL SEISMIC PROGRAM EAST OF THEIR PARSONS LAKE  
GAS FIELD BUT WITHIN THE AREA YOU HAVE INDICATED AS AREA 'A'  
YOUR REACTIONS TO THIS LAND USE PERMIT WERE PROVIDED IN CORRESPOND-  
ENCE TO MY REGIONAL DIRECTOR AT THE END OF DECEMBER TO MY DEPUTY  
MINISTER AND MYSELF OPPOSING THIS PROGRAM  
YOU HAVE STATED YOU ARE SEEKING A DELAY FOR SIX MONTHS SO THAT LAND  
CLAIMS FOR THE WESTERN ARCTIC CAN BE NEGOTIATED  
A SUPPORTIVE REQUEST HAS BEEN RECEIVED FROM THE VICE PRESIDENT OF  
THE TUK HUNTERS AND TRAPPERS ASSOCIATION

AS STATED ABOVE I WANT TO ENSURE THE CONTINUATION OF TRADITIONAL  
USES OF THE LAND WHILE ANY DEVELOPMENT RELATED ACTIVITY TAKES PLACE  
BECAUSE OF THE CONFLICTING INFORMATION I HAVE RECEIVED IN THIS  
REGARD AND PARTICULAR IMPORTANCE OF THIS AREA I HAVE DECIDED TO  
INVOKES SECTION 20 (1) (C) OF TERRITORIAL LAND USE REGULATIONS AND  
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FURTHERMORE I HAVE TODAY DIRECTED MY OFFICIALS TO ENGAGE THE SERVICES  
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ON THE FOLLOWING

- (A) IDENTIFY IN COLLABORATION WITH APPROPRIATE HUNTERS AND  
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- (B) AREAS WITHIN AREA 'A' WHERE EXPLORATION COULD ACCEPTABLY  
OCCUR WITHOUT DETRIMENT TO TRADITIONAL PURSUITS AND THE  
APPROPRIATE ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS THAT SHOULD CONTROL  
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- (C) THAT PORTION OF AREA A IN WHICH NO CLEAR PRIORITY CAN BE  
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SHOULD BE FOLLOWED TO GOVERN LAND USE

WHEN THIS REPORT IS COMPLETED THE LAND USE ADVISORY COMMITTEE WILL  
SEEK THE VIEWS OF THE COUNCILS CONCERNED AS WELL AS THE HUNTERS  
AND TRAPPERS ASSOCIATIONS AND AT THAT TIME I WILL DECIDE ON THE  
PRECISE AREAS TO BE PROTECTED AND THE FORM OF THAT PROTECTION

THIS REPORT WILL BE AVAILABLE TO ME BY AUGUST 1/77  
IT MUST BE CLEARLY UNDERSTOOD THAT ONCE THIS REVIEW IS COMPLETED  
AND SPECIAL PROTECTIONS IN PLACE EXPLORATION WILL BE PERMITTED  
UNDER THE APPROPRIATE ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS
