Dear Mayor Tinashlu:

Thanks for your letter requesting television service for the Hamlet of Repulse Bay.

The hamlet is scheduled to receive this service, along with the CBC's regional radio programming out of Frobisher Bay, during the 1981-82 fiscal year.

The money to pay for the facility and its installation will have to be approved by the Northwest Territories Legislative Assembly during its budget session in February of 1981.

As you know, our northern communications program, is designed to provide services to 18 communities in the N.W.T. with populations between 250 to 500. So far, services have been provided to Fort Norman, Fort Liard, Coral Harbour, Chesterfield Inlet, Arctic Bay and Pelly Bay.

We would have liked to be in a position to establish more than just three satellite stations a year in the Territories during the first two years of our program, but it was not financially possible.

The availability of small diameter (12-foot) satellite dishes and the related electronic equipment was also limited.

Regardless, I believe we have now found a way to complete our program in four years instead of five and as a result we will be able to service your hamlet a year earlier than originally planned.
