Motion Adopted by Constitutional Conference

Be it resolved that the participants at this Conference endorse a united front of all the major groups representing northern peoples to deal with questions of political and constitutional change.

Be it further resolved that the participants at this Conference agree to exchange ideas, proposals and thoughts on process and principles and details of political and constitutional change and development for the N.W.T.

Be it resolved that a committee be struck. This committee will be made up of representatives of the groups from territorial and community governments and the major native organizations. Its mandate will be to co-ordinate and develop a process to guarantee public involvement, community consultation and to provide information. This committee will report back to this group in a meeting to be held no later than May 30, 1982.

Be it further resolved that the Special Committee of Constitutional Development recommend to the Legislative Assembly that consideration be given for providing resources required for the committee to conduct its mandate.

Adopted with two opposing votes and one abstention January 22, 1982.
