Purchasing Surplus Material from the Government of the N.W.T.



Introduction

The purpose of this booklet is to let you know that material not needed by the Government of the Northwest Territories is available to you, the public. The booklet attempts to answer some of the more common questions associated with the purchase of surplus material, such as:

- where and how the material is sold
- the conditions of sale
- and an indication of the types of material available.

More information can be obtained by contacting our staff at the centres listed in this booklet.

Surplus Sales

The Department of Government Services, through its Supply Division, is responsible for marketing assets surplus to the requirements of all N.W.T. Government departments. The division also sells material on behalf of certain Crown Corporations such as the N.W.T. Housing Corporation and N.W.T. Workers Compensation Board.

The objective of the division is to market surplus material in a prompt and orderly manner and, in so doing, to realize the best possible proceeds on the sale of the material for the tax payer.

Types of Surplus Material Available

Due to the very large variety of material available through the Supply Services Division it is impractical to attempt to list it all here. The following, however, will give an idea of some of the more common items:

office furniture
business machines
electrical appliances
laboratory equipment
cars
trucks
trailers
boats

construction material
kitchen and laundry equipment
electronic equipment
tractors and machinery
electrical equipment
household furnishings

How to Purchase Surplus Material

Material is made available to the general public by means of public tender and auction. It is sold to the highest bidder and generally offered for sale in quantities which are suitable for the individual buyer. Large quantity buyers are neither favoured nor discriminated against.

Tender Sales

- Tender sales are normally conducted from Supply Centres listed in this booklet.
- Surplus material is received at the sales outlets where it is identified and tagged. In some cases a reserve figure may appear on all items for sale and it indicates the lowest value for which an item will be sold.
- Items for sale are usually displayed for a period of at least 21 days, depending on the type of items involved. Tender closing dates and times are specified in the sales advertisement.
- Sales outlets are open to the public from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.
- The public are invited to visit the sales outlets to view the merchandise available for sale. If they are interested in a particular item, it is simply a matter of determining what they are prepared to pay for it, completing a bid form, and mailing it in a sealed envelope to the sales outlet.

Tips on Filling Out Bid Forms

- It is important that prospective purchasers read the terms and conditions section on the back of the bid form before completing it.
- The general information portion of the bid form must be completed in a legible manner and must indicate the bidder's name, address, telephone number, and sale number. Sale number, lot number, and reserve value are marked on all items available for sale.
- In cases where similar items are offered for sale, bidders are able to bid on several of the items but acquire only one, if that is their wish. Bidders should state their order of preference on the bid form.

- Bid forms must be dated and signed by the bidder.

Opening of Bids

Bid openings take place at the Supply Centres and the public may attend these functions.

Notification

When all bid forms have been processed, and the highest bid for each lot determined, the successful bidder is notified by telephone. The Government of the N.W.T. reserves the right to reject, in whole or in part, any or all tenders.

Picking up Merchandise

All purchases must be paid for by money order, or certified cheque. The successful bidder must pay for and remove material within specified time limits.

Removal of material is not permitted unless it is paid for. Once paid for, material must be removed within 21 days by the purchaser.

Auction Sales

Surplus Material is sold by auction at various locations throughout the N.W.T. on an as-required basis. Privately-owned auction companies conduct the sales, and advertise them in local newspapers.

Material sold by auction is made available in the normal auction manner, which means the highest bidder for each item is the successful buyer.

Warranties, Refunds and Adjustments

In all cases, prospective purchasers are encouraged to inspect material prior to placing bids, to assure themselves as to the condition and suitability for intended purposes. Because we do not know the condition of material provided to us by government departments, all material is sold on an 'As Is, Where Is' basis. There is no warranty expressed or implied. The successful bidder is always afforded the opportunity to inspect merchandise prior to concluding the purchase. However, once merchandise
