1. Baffin Regional Hunter's and Trapper's Committee are not supporting the search and rescue committee enough, whenever they have a meeting all they talk about is wildlife and they never talk about the well being of the people.
2. For the reasons of the Renewable Resources ski-doods and boats cannot be used by the search and rescue team.
3. The search and rescue committee is requesting for support from the Baffin Regional Council, and from the Baffin Region members of the Legislative Assembly, who are suppose to be supporting the people of Baffin Region.

- 3 C.B. radios, since the team does not even have one radio although it is really necessary.
- 6 thermal sleeping bags.
- Gasoline to last a whole year.
- Food supplies, since the hunters who are lost or stuck out in the country usually run out of food, this would really be beneficial to them.
- 2 Ski-doo's, since there tends to be a problem when we use privately owned Ski-doo's, all these request were made with the full support of the Search and Rescue Committee.
