

To whom it may concern:

The Hamlet of Baker Lake in their regular meeting of the 21 May 85 expressed their deep concern over the short periods of time a person receives when their are charged with sexual matters and abuse. People who are repeated offenders of these two criminal acts, seem to receive relatively short periods of incarceration. Although Council does not want to play judge, they would like to recommend that a stiffer penalty be given to those members of society who are repeatedly committing these crimes. The people of Baker Lake can no longer tolerate this type of behavior and we hope your department will make every effort to comply with our recommendation for stiffer penalties for these two types of criminal acts.
