Subject: AIRCRAFT REFUELLING

Dear Silas:

It has come to our attention that, on occasion, you have refueled aircraft directly from your fuel oil truck. This practice is against Shell policy and must be discontinued.

The reasons for this policy are as follows:

- A- There is not bulk Jet Fuel in Sanikilueg, only Diesel;
- B- Your delivery truck is not equipped with Aviation filters;
- C- Your truck is not equipped with adequate ground cables for aviation refueling.

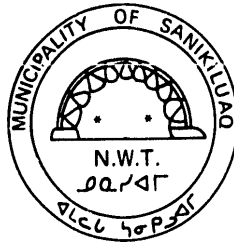
Therefore, we insist that you no longer fuel any aircraft from your truck. Any enquiries relating to the above subject are to be addressed to the undersigned.

Dear Moses;

It was brought to councils attention that there are couple of urgent problems facing our fuel service here in Sanikiluaq and in councils meeting a motion was passed to reflect that- motion #R-4-86-5 (attached).

For one thing, there isn't anymore jet fuel for aircrafts to refuel here in Sanikiluaq and we get charter services from Churchill who come in to pick up patients to hospital, some aircrafts are using substitute fuel which isn't safe thing to do but there is no alternative here.


Another thing is there isn't any equipment to refuel and aircraft, as per attached letter will explain, so what they have been doing is by using hand pump which isn't very fast and it takes one and half hour to refuel the plane.

So we feel we have been very lucky at this point without any major accidents or without waiting 2 hrs for aircraft to refuel.

I hope this matter is given top priority, thanking you for your concern.
