



THE STAFFING POLICY AS ANNOUNCED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION WILL HAVE A TREMENDOUS NEGATIVE EFFECT ON THE EDUCATION SERVICES OFFERED AT J.B.T.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND P.W.K. HIGH SCHOOL.
THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL HAS BEEN INSTRUCTED TO REDUCE ITS STAFF BY THREE WITHIN THE NEXT YEAR. THESE CUTS COULD COME FROM THE SPECIAL PROGRAMS. EXAMPLES OF SPECIAL PROGRAMS ARE FRENCH, PHYSICAL EDUCATION OR SPECIAL EDUCATION. ALTERNATIVELY CLASS SIZE WILL HAVE TO BE INCREASED. NEXT SCHOOL YEAR THE HIGH SCHOOL'S HOME ECONOMICS AND THE MUSIC PROGRAM WILL NOT BE TAUGHT. WHEN OTHER TEACHERS LEAVE THERE WILL BE FURTHER PROGRAM CUTS.

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION MUST RECOGNIZE THAT A SOUND STAFFING POLICY CANNOT BE BASED ON A SIMPLE MATHEMATICAL FORMULA ALONE. THE NEEDS OF ALL SCHOOLS AND STUDENTS MUST BE GIVEN EQUAL CONSIDERATION.

THE PULLING DOWN OF HIGH STANDARDS OF PROGRAMS IN ONE COMMUNITY TO ENHANCE INADEQUATE PROGRAMS IN OTHER COMMUNITIES IS A POOR WAY TO ENHANCE EDUCATION FOR ALL N.W.T. RESIDENTS.

WE THE UNDERSIGNED RESIDENTS OF FORT SMITH DEMAND THAT THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION DESIST FROM IMPLEMENTING THE STAFFING POLICY IN QUESTION UNTIL FULL INPUT HAS BEEN REQUESTED AND RECEIVED FROM ALL LOCAL EDUCATION AUTHORITIES, EDUCATION SOCIETIES AND PUBLIC.
