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MINISTERIAL ACTION FORCE ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Government of the N.W.T. Ministerial Action Force, has been established in response to the current economic downturn in the north to act as a territorial counterpart to the Federal Action Force on Arctic Initiatives. The specific responsibilities of this committee are as follows:

Functions

1. To co-ordinate N.W.T. initiatives in the area of economic development.
2. To maintain liaison with the Federal Action Force on Arctic Initiatives with a view to co-ordinating N.W.T. initiatives with federal ones.
3. To oversee the work of the N.W.T. Officials' Working Group on short term mitigative initiatives.
4. To maintain close liaison with the Devolution Secretariat, the departments affected, and the native organizations where economic initiatives or strategies overlap with or directly impact upon the process of devolution.

Objectives

1. To develop broad economic development strategies for the N.W.T. in concert with the federal government.
2. To initiate short term and site-specific projects in response to regional economic problems such as the downturn in Beaufort exploration, mine closures, etc.
3. To adapt the existing fiscal and economic framework as a response to current economic problems -- both regional and territory-wide.

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
