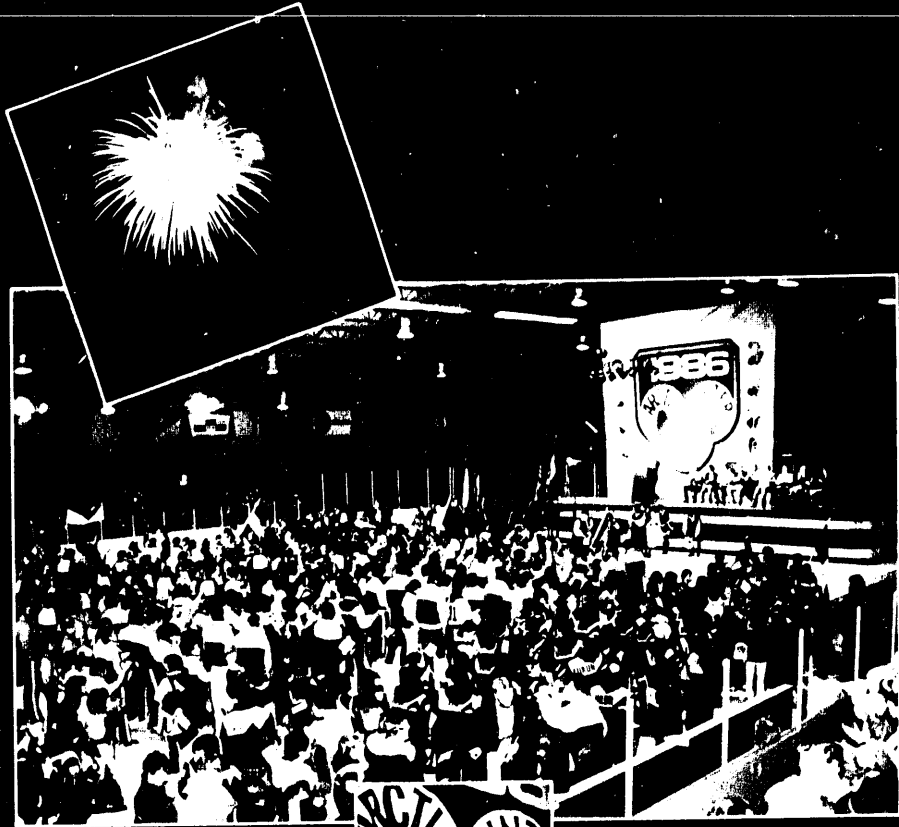

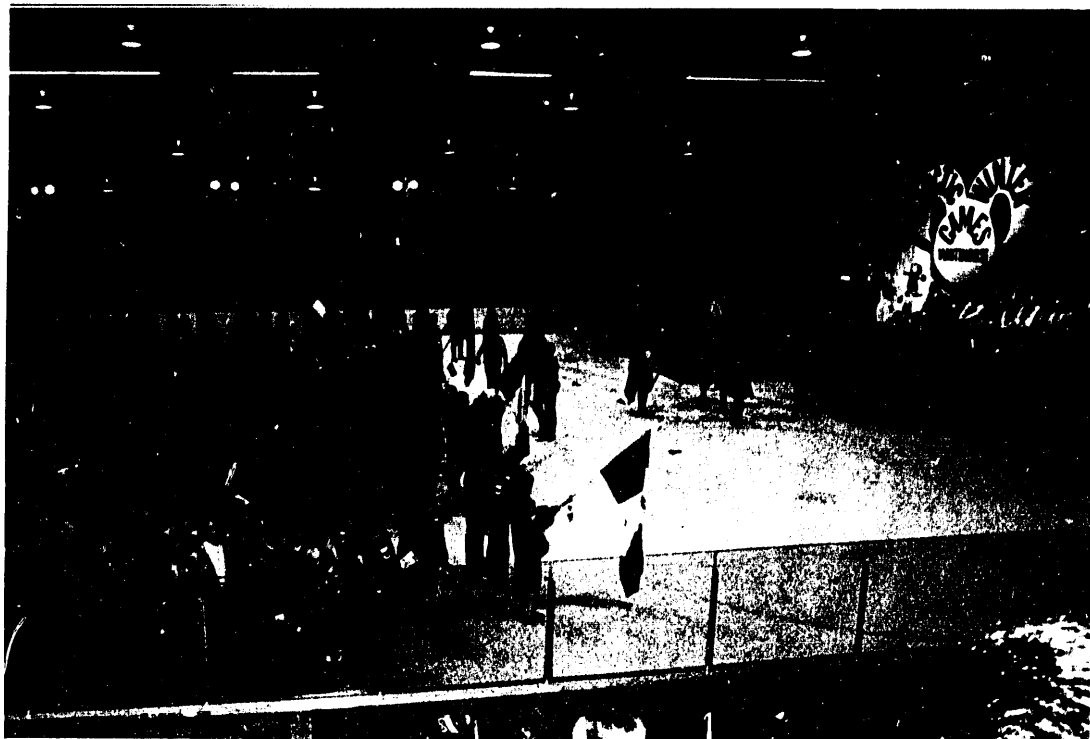

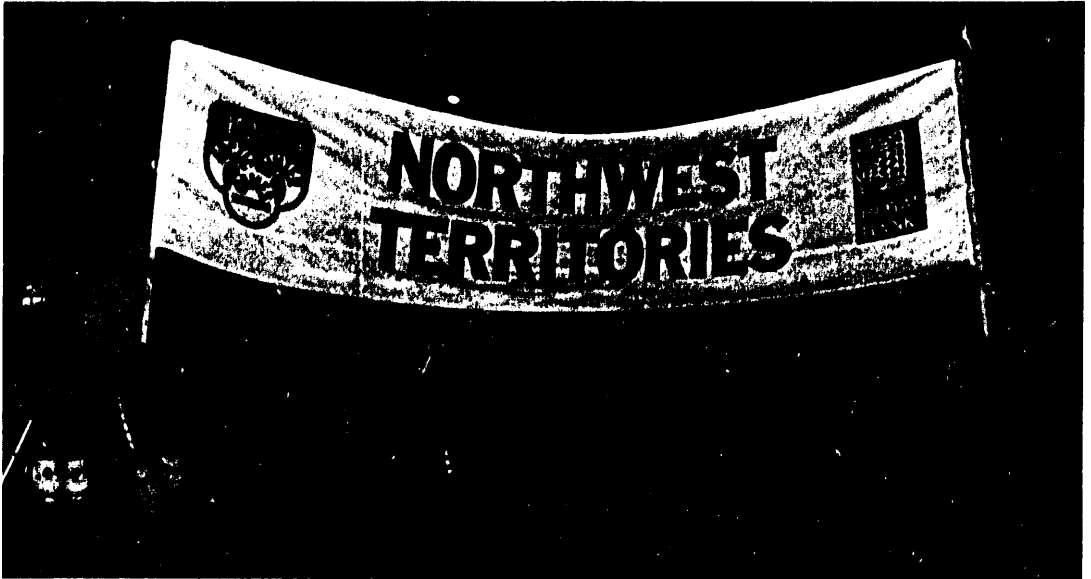

ARCTIC WINTER GAMES



The Arctic Winter Games concept was conceived as a result of discussions among Government officials from Alaska, the Yukon Territory and the Northwest Territories. The main objectives of the Games were to provide northern athletes with the opportunity to improve their skills against athletes of similar background and ability and to foster friendship and understanding among all people of the Arctic through sport and cultural activities. In 1970, the first Arctic Winter Games were successfully staged in Yellowknife, involving athletes from Alaska, the Yukon and the Northwest Territories. Subsequent games were successfully held in Whitehorse, Yukon 1972; Anchorage, Alaska 1974; Schefferville, Quebec 1976; Hay River/Pine Point, N.W.T. 1978; Whitehorse, Yukon 1980; Fairbanks, Alaska 1982; and Yellowknife, N.W.T. 1984.

The host for the 9th Arctic Winter Games was Whitehorse, Yukon and more than 900 volunteers supported the Host Society to prepare for the 1,000 athletes from Alaska, the N.W.T., Yukon and, for the first time a small contingent from Northern Alberta. Athletes, coaches, officials, dignitaries and spectators were impressed by the organization and friendliness of the Whitehorse hosts. On behalf of team N.W.T. a huge thank you to all the people of Whitehorse, Yukon.

In 1988 the Arctic Winter Games will be held in Fairbanks, Alaska where Northern athletes will again participate in the North's most prestigious sporting event in search of the gold, silver and bronze ulus, symbolic of Northern athletic achievement.

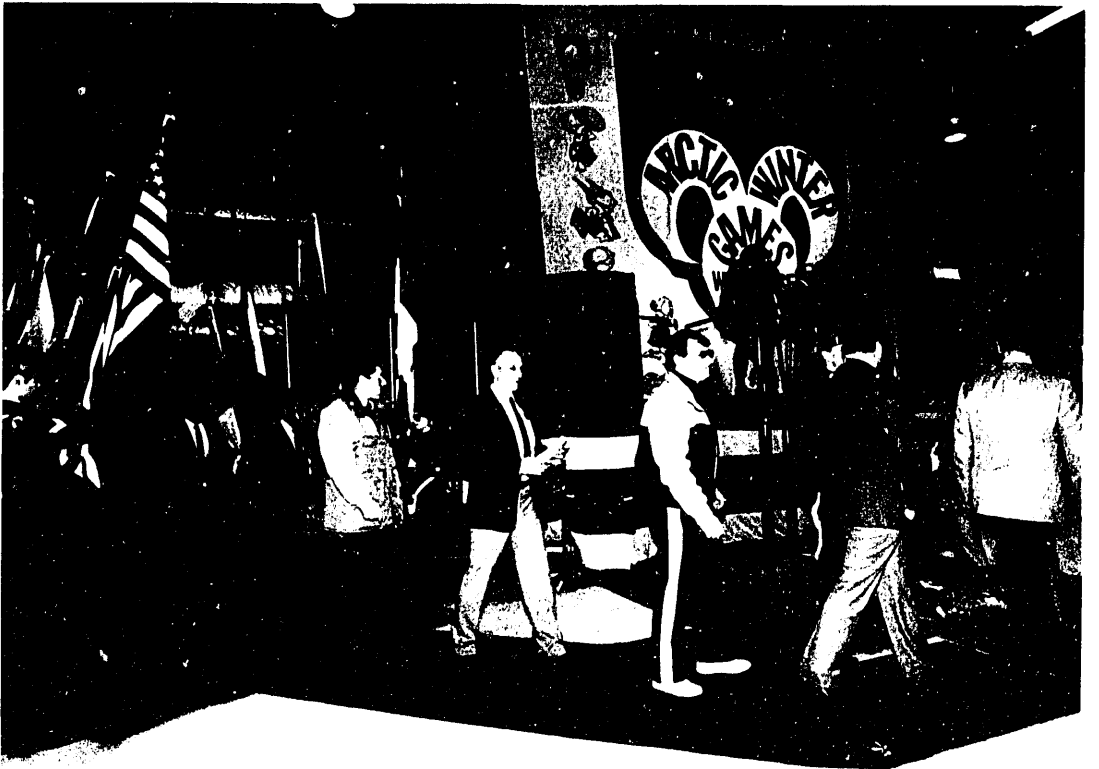
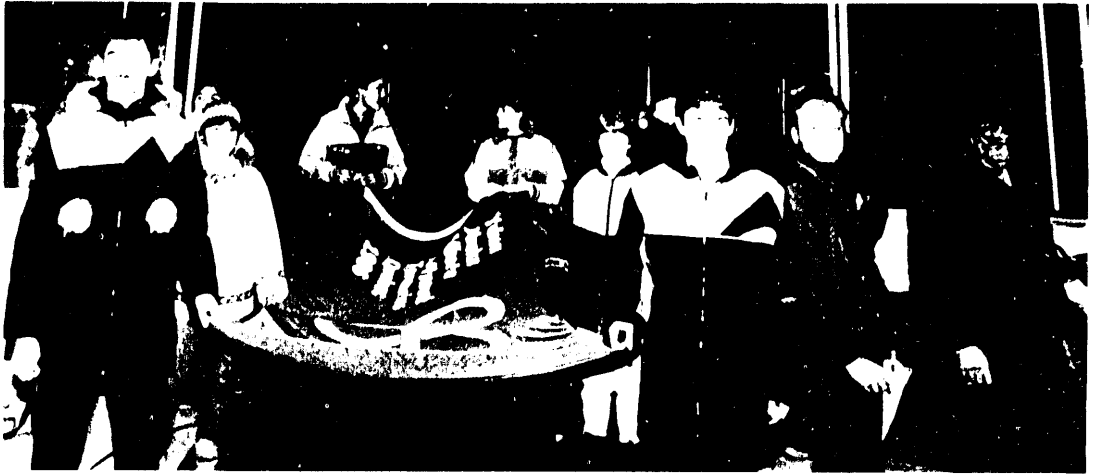
TEAM NORTHWEST TERRITORIES

The co-ordination, selection and participation of the Arctic Winter Games Team is the responsibility of the Sport North Federation, their committees and vast resource of volunteers from across the N.W.T. The Government of the Northwest Territories, with support and liaison by the Sport and Recreation Division of the Department of Municipal and Community Affairs, has delegated this responsibility to Sport North. To carry out this responsibility Sport North established an Arctic Winter Games Committee comprised of a Chairperson, three members and seven regional co-ordinators representing the regions identified for the Games. The committee was responsible for finances, logistics, athletic attire, and administration of the team selection. The regional co-ordinators were responsible for dissemination of information, registration of athletes, co-ordination of transportation for Regional and Territorial Trials as well as liaison with the N.W.T. Sport Governing Bodies for the conduct of the Trials.

Over 2,000 athletes from 37 communities participated in the Regional Trials, representing an increase of 447 athletes or 22% over participation in 1984. At the N.W.T. Trials 1,150 athletes from 32 communities competed for 303 positions to represent the N.W.T. at the Arctic Winter Games. At the Games in Whitehorse the Northwest Territories Team finished second overall, behind Team Alaska, with 119 ulus: 33 gold, 38 silver and 48 bronze.

Congratulations go out to all the athletes who represented the N.W.T. They demonstrated true sportmanship and by their actions enhanced the basic principle of the Games of fostering friendship and understanding among Northern people through sport.

We hope this souvenir book will help you to fondly remember the 1986 Arctic Winter Games.

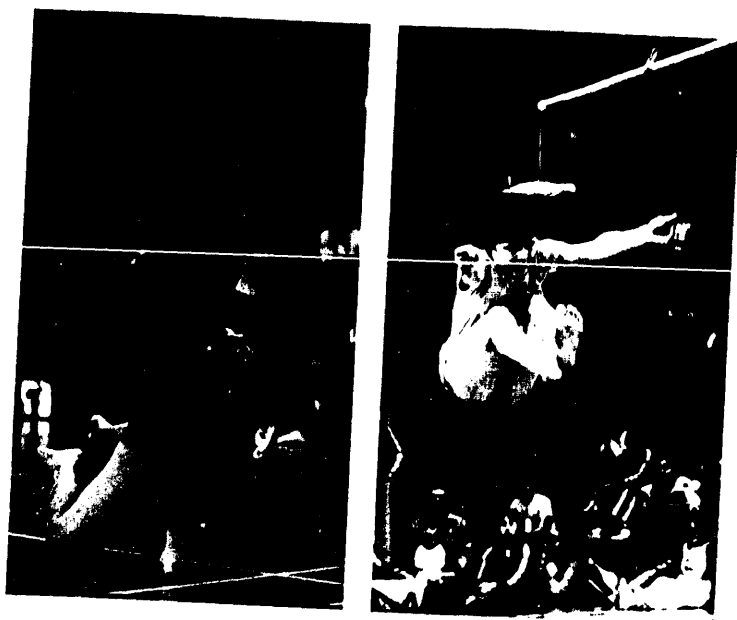
The Games also foster a greater understanding of our neighbours and ourselves as individuals. Such understanding is so important in the world today.
