

## Votes and Proceedings

### SECOND SESSION OF THE NINETEENTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

June 10, 2020

The Assembly commenced sitting at 1:33 pm with the Honourable Frederick Blake Jr., Speaker, presiding.


The motion was CARRIED.
