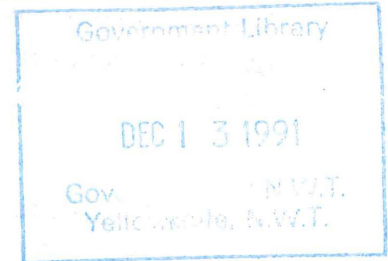

- More training opportunities for trades people and make the training available at a local level eg: Not in Fort Smith, Inuvik, etc.
- The Government must develop a good working relationship with Private industry to encourage enviornmentally sound development of our Mineral and Renewable resources while creating employment and training in relevant areas to the future of our area.
- More exposure of our Young people to the outside world and the opportunities available to the public sector in training employment and life. eg: Expo, student exchanges, school trips, etc.
