The following process for abortion care is standard in Gove sate N.M.C. Yellowknife.

Government Library

Yellowknile, N. V.T.

- Physical exam and questionaire.
- 2. Ultrasound
- Informed consent
- Counselling prior to the procedure from the doctor and nurse.
- Prophylactic antibiotics
- Laminaria tent insertion pight before (1 or more)
- Operation room: <u>+intravenous</u> +oral analgesia example: Pentanyl -curetage by suction -local anesthesia if dilation needed
- 8. Return to daycare -teaching
- Return in 1 6 weeks for follow-up 9.
- 10. Over 16 weeks -prostaglandins or referrals

These procedures have been reviewed in discussion and in writing with Stanton Yellowknife Hospital as those which are adhered to in regards to therapeutic abortions. The procedures meet the standards of care promoted by the SOGC.
