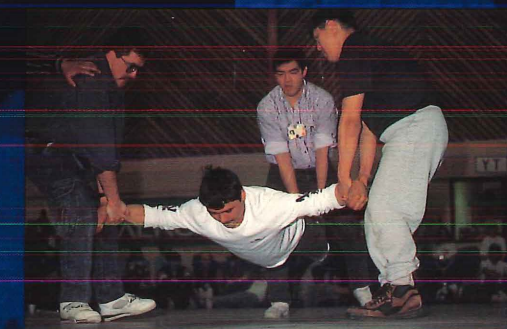

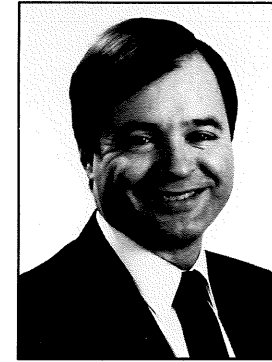

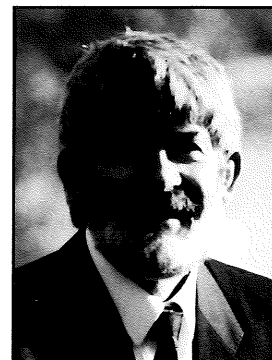

# President's Message

As President of the Sport North Federation, I would like to congratulate the NWT Contingent for an outstanding performance at the 1992 Arctic Winter Games. It was indicative as I made it through each venue, that our athletes were very well prepared both competitively and as ambassadors of the NWT. This is a tribute to the coaches and respective Territorial Sport Organizations.

It is important to note the significance of the NWT Regional and Territorial playdowns which saw a combined registration of 2,432 participants. This can be largely attributed to the commitment of all the various partners to this major event: The Government of the Northwest Territories, Sport North Federation, AWG Regional Coordinators, Host Communities and finally all the volunteers who committed countless number of hours to ensure the various trials were the success they were. When one realizes that 50 communities registered for the Regional Trials and 45 communities were represented at the Territorial Trials, one can understand why this NWT Contingent showed the best regional representation ever at an Arctic Winter Games.

The Games themselves were extremely competitive but retained that friendly atmosphere which makes the Arctic Winter Games unique. We need to be aware that these Games not only provide us with a major sporting event but an ability to bring northern people together to exchange friendships and cultural differences.

I would like to close by congratulating Chef De Mission, Dave Hurley, the Assistant Chef, Donald Clark, their staff and all the athletes and coaches who represented us so well, culminating with the NWT winning their first ever Stuart Hodgson Trophy.

# Games History

The Arctic Winter Games concept was conceived as a result of discussions among Government officials from Alaska, Yukon and the Northwest Territories. The main objectives of the Games were to provide northern athletes with the opportunity to improve their skills against athletes of similar background and ability, and to foster friendship and understanding among all people of the Arctic through sport and cultural activities. In 1970 the first Arctic Winter Games were successfully staged in Yellowknife, N.W.T. involving athletes from Alaska, Yukon and the Northwest Territories. Subsequent games were successfully staged in Whitehorse, Yukon in 1972; Anchorage, Alaska in 1974; Schefferville, Quebec in 1976; Hay River/Pine Point, N.W.T. in 1978; Whitehorse, Yukon in 1980; Fairbanks, Alaska in 1982; Yellowknife, N.W.T. in 1984; Whitehorse, Yukon in 1986; and Fairbanks, Alaska in 1988, Yellowknife, N.W.T. in 1990, and Whitehorse, Yukon in 1992.

In 1994 the Arctic Winter Games will be held in Slave Lake, Alberta where Northern Athletes will again participate in the North's most prestigious sporting event in search of the gold, silver and bronze ulus, symbolic of Northern athletic achievement.

The coordination, selection and participation of the Arctic Winter Games Team is the responsibility of the Sport North Federation, their committees and their vast resource of volunteers from across the Northwest Territories. The Government of the Northwest Territories, through the Sport and Recreation Division of the Department of Municipal and Community Affairs, has delegated this responsibility to Sport North. To carry out this responsibility Sport North establishes an Arctic Winter Games Committee comprised of a Chairperson, three members and 7 regional coordinators representing the regions identified for the Games. The committee was responsible for finances, logistics, athletic attire, and administration of team selection. The regional coordinators were responsible for dissemination of information, registration of athletes, coordination of transportation for Regional and Territorial Trials as well as liaison with the N.W.T. Sport Organizations for the conduct of the Trials.

Over 2400 athletes from 50 communities participated in the Regional Trials. At the N.W.T. Trials 1366 athletes from 45 communities competed for the 303 positions to represent the N.W.T. at the Arctic Winter Games. At the Games in Whitehorse the Northwest Territories Team finished third overall with 93 Ulus: 25 Gold, 33 Silver and 35 Bronze.

Congratulations go out to all the athletes who represented the N.W.T. They demonstrated true sportsmanship and fair play and by their actions enhanced the basic principle of the Games of fostering friendship and understanding among Northern people through sport.

We hope this souvenir book will help you fondly remember the 1992 Arctic Winter Games.
